Minors

BronyCAN is intended for attendees of all ages, but we require that all children 11 years of age and younger be accompanied by a parent or designated guardian over the age of 18. All designated guardians over the age of 18 must have purchased an adult badge for BronyCAN, and as children 11 years of age and younger receive the Youth pass for free, children between the age of 12-17 must buy a standard pass. In addition, those individuals 16 years of age or under do require parental consent.

Please be aware that BronyCAN and associated parties are not responsible for supervision of minors, and that by registering to attend this convention, all parties understand and agree to this limitation.

Pets and Service Animals

In following with the hotel policy, service animals are allowed for attendees that require them. BronyCAN asks that you leave your pets at home or in the care of someone that you can trust while you are enjoying the convention.

Photography and Video Recording

Cameras and video recording are welcome at BronyCAN and are allowed at most panels and spaces through the convention. There are several points of common courtesy to be aware of when taking pictures however. When taking pictures in the public convention spaces, such as hallways and lobby, please make sure you are not blocking other attendee's movement or impeding crowd traffic if there happens to be many attendees in one space.

While in the vendor's hall, please do not take pictures or record any of the vendor's items unless you have their express permission. Finally, be respectful of anyone in the convention who does not wish to be photographed or recorded on video. Most guests, whether they are attendees in cosplay or guests of honor, would prefer to be asked if photos or video recordings are taken.

BronyCAN staff reserve the right to prohibit photography, recording, and other forms of capture during certain events and in certain spaces.

Public Behavior

Please be aware of your behavior in any of the convention spaces. BronyCAN expressly prohibits disruptive and unsafe behavior, including, but not limited to: verbal and physical harassment towards others, acts that could be dangerous to others or property, sexual misconduct, engaging in illegal activities, and possession of any item that is defined as a weapon.

Violations will be handled on a case by case basis, and a BronyCAN volunteer will often ask attendees exhibiting any such behavior to refrain. Other violations by their very nature will result in immediate and permanent expulsion from BronyCAN, and volunteers will contact the appropriate authorities if necessary.

Please do not sleep in the convention spaces. All attendees should return to their rooms or accommodations to sleep, as convention and public hotel spaces are not authorized for overnight sleeping.

Weapons and Props

Cosplayers at conventions often have a number of accessories and props that go with their chosen costume. Some of these items may resemble a weapon however, and for the safety and comfort of all attendees, BronyCAN has strict guidelines on weapons and costume props.

Possession of any weapon in violation of applicable law is expressly prohibited. Functional projectile weapons (firearms), will not be allowed, even if the owner has a weapon permit or concealed carry permit. Any attendee found in possession of a weapon will be subject to action including and up to immediate expulsion from the convention and alerting the appropriate authorities.

All items that resemble weapons must be peace-bonded, which means that a very visible lock has been placed on the weapon to make it clear it will not be used for violent means. A piece of cloth, a brightly colored zip tie, or something similarly visible over the trigger of gun-like prop, or holding a blade in its sheath would be an example of peace-bonding.

Please peace-bond any items that may resemble weapons before arriving at BronyCAN, or contact a BronyCAN volunteer to have your props peace-bonded. BronyCAN reserves the right to have convention volunteers require peace-bonding or the removal of a weapon at their discretion.

No functioning or previously functioning projectile weapons are allowed, including but not limited to water guns, silly string guns, air soft or pellet guns. Nerf guns are only acceptable in the official Nerf War, pending inspection. Gun replicas and projectile weapon replicas should never be pointed at anyone at any time. Replica pistols must remain holstered, and replica rifles should be slung in a manner that leaves them immobile at all times in the convention space.

All laser pointers are prohibited. *No exceptions.*

All bladed weapons must remain sheathed or cased at all times in the convention space. Play-acting with props and weapons is prohibited, as props should never be waved around. No live steel props are allowed, which includes anything that resembles a sword, knife, or other bladed weapon that can take a sharp edge.

Policy Revision

BronyCAN policies are subject to change at any time the convention requires.

Additional Information

All membership purchases at BronyCAN are non-refundable (this does not cover defective or missing merchandise).

No refunds will be issued for attendees removed from the convention for violating BronyCAN policies, hotel policies, or laws.

If there is a question that you have that our policies didn't cover, please ask a BronyCAN volunteer for additional information or clarification. We strive to ensure that all attendees have a pleasant and safe convention, so please inform any volunteers if you feel that you or others are having a less-than-safe experience.

ATTENDEE CONDUCT

Introduction

Our foremost goal at BronyCAN is to ensure that all attendees have a pleasant and memorable time at our convention. The following policies are set in place by BronyCAN staff to ensure that every individual attendee will enjoy their time at our convention, so please keep these in mind for a fun and safe experience.

As a friendly reminder, please remember the 6-2-1 rule: 6 hours of sleep, 2 full meals, and 1 shower per day at an absolute minimum to ensure you and everyone else have a great time!

General Rating

BronyCAN is, for all intents and purposes, intended for attendees of all ages and has adopted a 'PG' rating as such. This means that attendees should refrain from strong language, displays of violence, inappropriate dress, and depictions of illegal or age-inappropriate behaviors, both real and fictional in all public areas of the convention. We want the youngsters and their guardians attending BronyCAN to enjoy their experience at our convention without the worry of running into something inappropriate.

Registration

For insurance and legal purposes, BronyCAN requires photo ID and age validation for all attendees on entrance to the convention.

We accept government-issued identification, such as driver's licences, passports, health care cards, etc. If you need to use more than one card to meet these requirements, that is acceptable - for example, if you have one government ID with your photo on it, and a separate ID card with your date of birth, you can present both together and they will be accepted.

Please note: we do not accept student ID cards except when being used as a supplementary card alongside a government issued ID, as described above.

If your legal name is not the name by which you go by in life, you may not wish to give your legal name to staff. However, BronyCAN does require that we have your legal name in the system for correct identification.

We understand that this can be disconcerting to some, such as transgendered individuals or those who utilise an alias in their daily lives. If this applies to you, you may nominate any member of the registration staff to validate your identification, at your discretion. You can be taken out of line to do so, if you so choose. Your legal name does not have to go on your attendee badge, and you do not have to be referred to by it at any point after the registration desk.

We at BronyCAN do not wish your stay with us to be uncomfortable, and we apologize for this necessary inconvenience.

Lost and Found

All abandoned items should be brought to the nearest convention volunteer, which will then be stored in the convention operations room during the weekend. BronyCAN will store and safeguard all lost items until August 22nd, after which these items will be disposed of in a manner that BronyCAN deems acceptable.

Alcohol and Prohibited Substances

All alcoholic beverages are prohibited in convention spaces, and anyone who appears intoxicated or under the influence of any substance will not be allowed into these areas. As the British Columbia drinking age is 19, minors that illegally consume or come into possession of alcohol may receive criminal charges, in addition to the party that provided the alcohol.

There is a strict zero-tolerance policy on serving alcohol to minors in violation of the law. Any such violations will result in BronyCAN staff immediately removing involved individuals from convention space and revoking their pass. BronyCAN staff will also file a report to the proper authorities for any violations of this law.

Any narcotic or hallucinogenic substances and paraphernalia are also strictly prohibited for any reason in convention space, and their possession or use will result in similar action.

Smoking

Please follow all hotel policies and local laws regarding smoking in the convention space and your hotel room. Within the City of Richmond, smoking is not permitted by law in all indoor public spaces, including public transit, shopping malls, restaurants, pubs, nightclubs and casinos. Smoking is not permitted within six metres of an entryway, openable window or air intake of a building. Signs will be posted to indicate the applicable smoking restrictions. Please smoke in designated areas only.

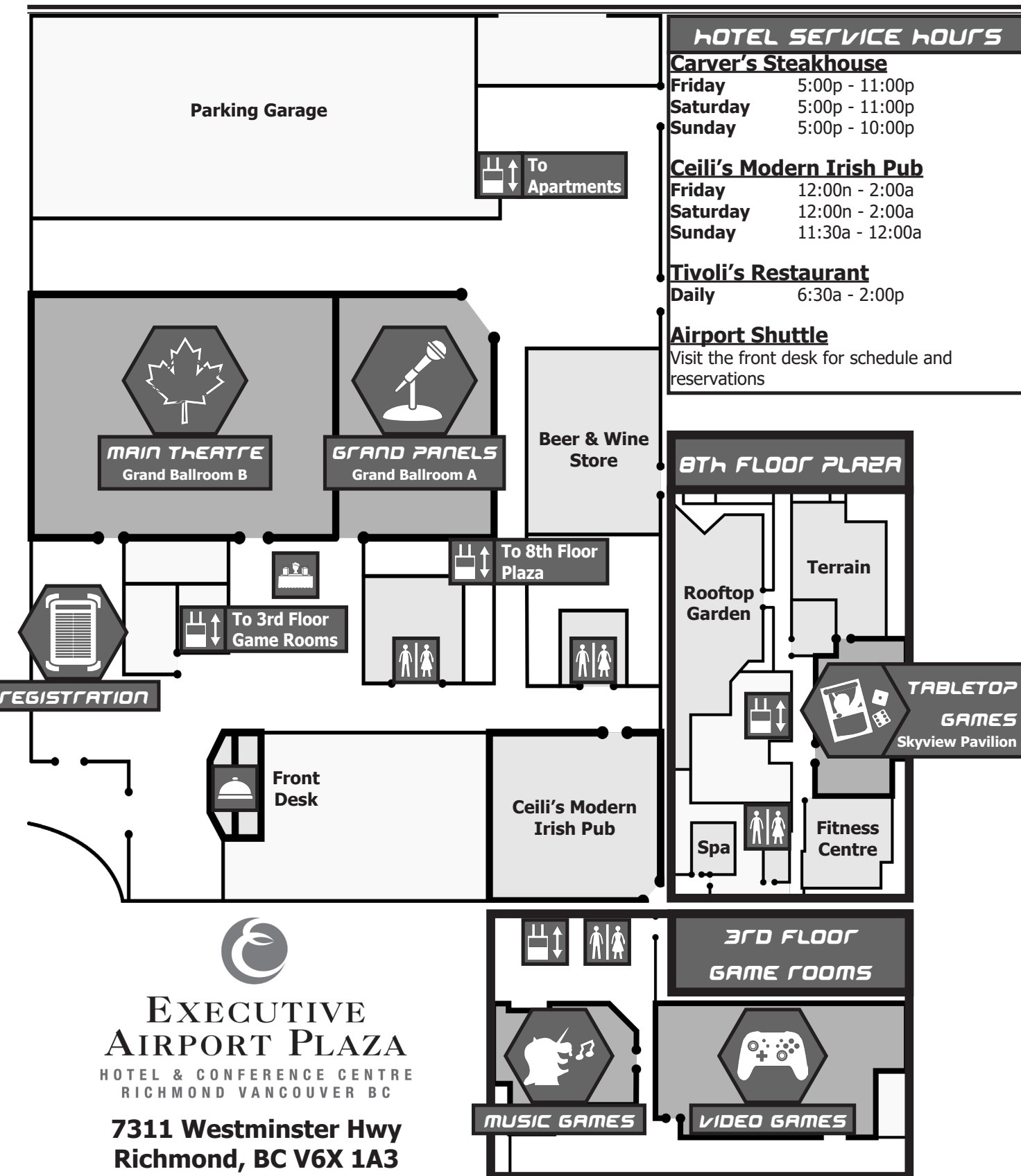
Hotel Policies

Media Coverage and Press

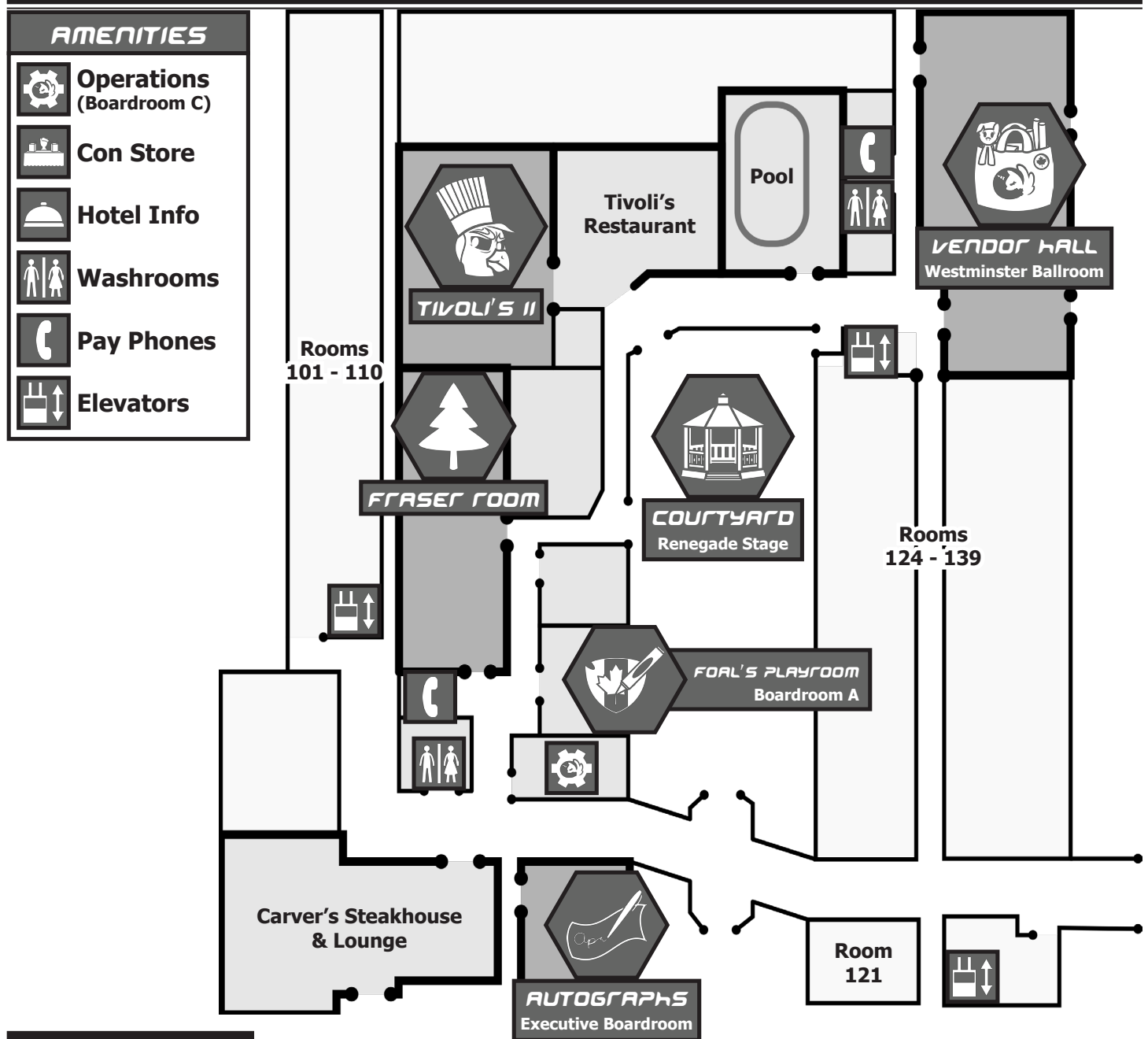

DANIEL INGRAM Composer & Songwriter

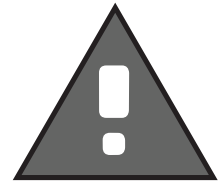

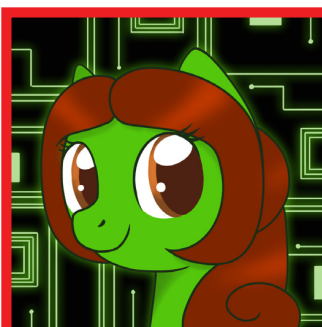

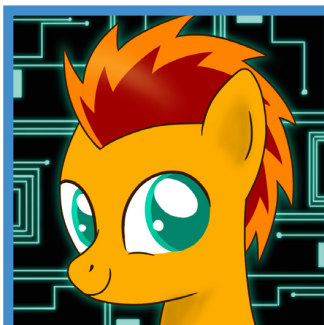
