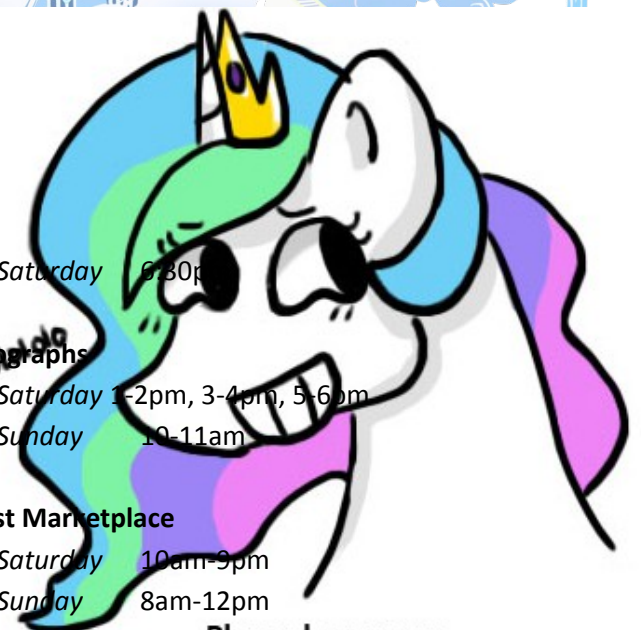

General Information

What is it about these "bronies"?

Bronies are fans of the series My Little Pony (MLP), specifically the most recent series called My Little Pony: Friendship is Magic (MLP:FIM). While it is a show ostensibly created for little girls, male the 'typical' Brony is a heterosexual male in his mid-20's. They can be or female, straight or gay, young or old. Bronies have created artistic works about the show, its characters, as well as art, fan fiction, music and hundreds of tropes.



Besides being shown in the United States, My Little Pony airs in dozens of countries, as well as having an Internet presence that spans the globe. This has created a universal fan base. From tiny islands off the coast of Africa to major cities like New York and LA, fans can be found the world wide.

What is Cloudsdale Congress?

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Cloudsdale Congress was made to celebrate and share the presence of East Coast bronies and all the artistic works that created by them. This convention is the brainchild of the Meetup.com brony groups from [Fillydelphia](#), [Washington, D.C.](#), [Western Maryland](#).

While the convention is located in the Washington, D.C. area, it is not just a DC Bronies event. Its staff is made up of members from all the groups, plus some others, and the convention is a collaborative effort that highlights everypony's hard work.

We are here to highlight local artists, musicians, voice talent, and much more. We do have guests that work on the show, but our focus is to bring to your attention supporting cast and crew and to highlight their efforts that contribute to the fandom and the greater animation world.. For example, we have invited Lee Tockar, voice of Snips and Stephen Magnet in MLP:FIM and CEO of Fanbuilt Productions, to join us and showcase his impressive new collaborative virtual animation studio. This con will also feature local voice actors, musicians, artists and costumers.

Is this your first time at a convention?

If so, congratulations! Conventions (or cons for short) are a great way to meet people with similar interests. Cloudsdale Congress is a convention specifically for fans of My Little Pony. In comparison, many conventions are for a much broader genre, such as science fiction, comic books, or anime. Fan conventions often have a life of their own, full of different people with different habits than you would often see every day on the street.

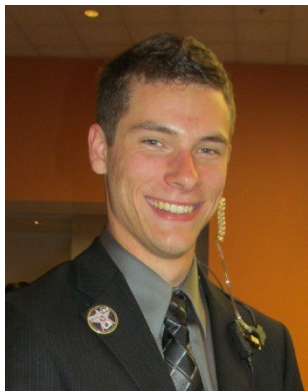
Conventions are home to what is typically the "geek" or "nerd" culture, which includes many people that may be reclusive and not used to social interaction. Some may be shy, some may be awkward, and some may not have bathed in quite a while. This is why we have rules for con-goers to follow to keep everyone socially presentable.

No matter what the reason for a fan convention, there will be fans wearing costumes that depict characters they love. This is called **cosplay** - short for "costume play". Costumes can be simple or complex, and may be "show-accurate" or combine 2 or more other works. One example is a Disney Princess that is dressed as a maid (an anime costume).

That understanding of shared morals, of common ground, that is what has allowed us to be the best possible versions of ourselves, all without the painful fear of rejection and abandonment that comes with putting ourselves on the line. It's beautiful. It is truly and absolutely beautiful.

So, now that you are here: go celebrate the fandom in the best ways that you can. My dedicated staff has worked very hard to ensure that you have fun, that you stay safe, and that you can come to share the same love for this fandom that has already uplifted and inspired so many of us.

Voice Actors



Michelle Creber is a 13 year old actor, singer, voiceover artist and dancer from Vancouver, Canada who is best known internationally as the voice of “Apple Bloom” as well as the singing voice for “Sweetie Belle” & “Apple Bloom” on My Little Pony, Friendship Is Magic.

Film & TV on-screen credits include Smart Cookies (Hallmark), The Haunting Hour (The Hub), Supernatural (CW), Eureka (NBC), Christmas Lodge (Showcase), Killer Among Us (Lifetime), and The Search for Santa Paws (Disney). In addition to her voice work on MLP, Michelle has voiced

many other characters including “Lucy” in Peanuts Motion Comics (Warner Bros), “Alice” in Martha Speaks (PBS Kids), “Teri” and “Michelle” on Dinosaur Train (Jim Henson) and “Jake” in Adventures of Little Jake & Many Skies (APTN). Theatre credits include the title role in Annie (twice), “Dorothy” in The Wizard of Oz, “Brigitta” in The Sound of Music and “Tiny Tim” in A Christmas Carol. Michelle’s various acting, musical and comedic skills are showcased in the new online variety show, Speedy & Stretch, which was recently launched on her YouTube channel. The show features classic & original comedy sketches as well as music videos and special guests.

In the summer of 2012, Michelle released her debut album entitled Timeless: Songs of a Century; a much acclaimed, multi-genre collection of top hits from 1910 to 2010. Timeless was immediately followed by the release of A Creber Christmas. Both collections feature vocal skills, style, power and versatility that defy Michelle’s young age. A talented song writer, Michelle is now working on a collection of original songs and enjoys playing piano, drums & guitar. She also loves a variety of sports, games, art, cooking, photography, family time and her two dogs, Max & Marley!

He was the creator and producer of "The Massive Smile Project", and is currently working as a songwriter on the fan-made feature-length film: "MLP:FiM Journey of the Spark".

Forest has landed several spots on Everfree Network's Top 100 Brony Songs of 2012, with notable tracks like "Join the Herd", "Hay Ms Derpy", and "Great to be Different" and he has been featured on Equestria Daily, Derpy Hooves News, Brony Talk Show, Everfree Radio, and Fillydelphia Radio.



MRP

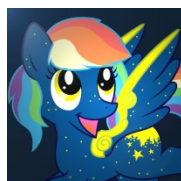

Starborne



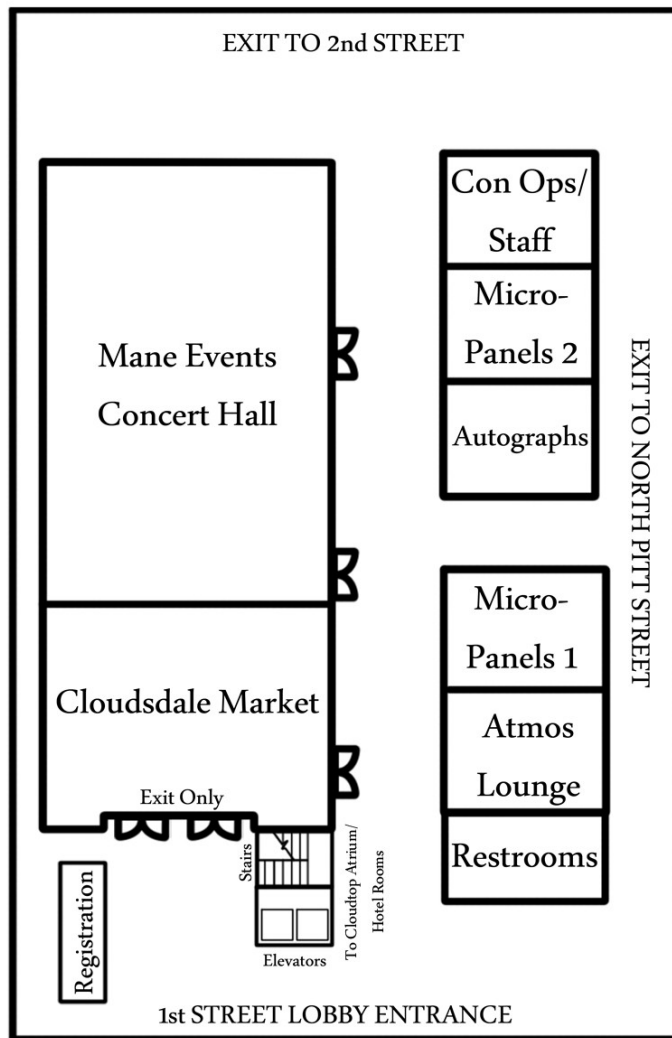

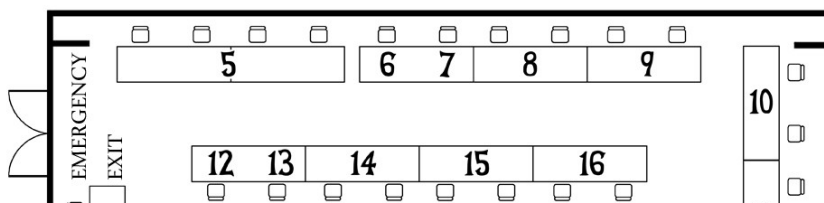

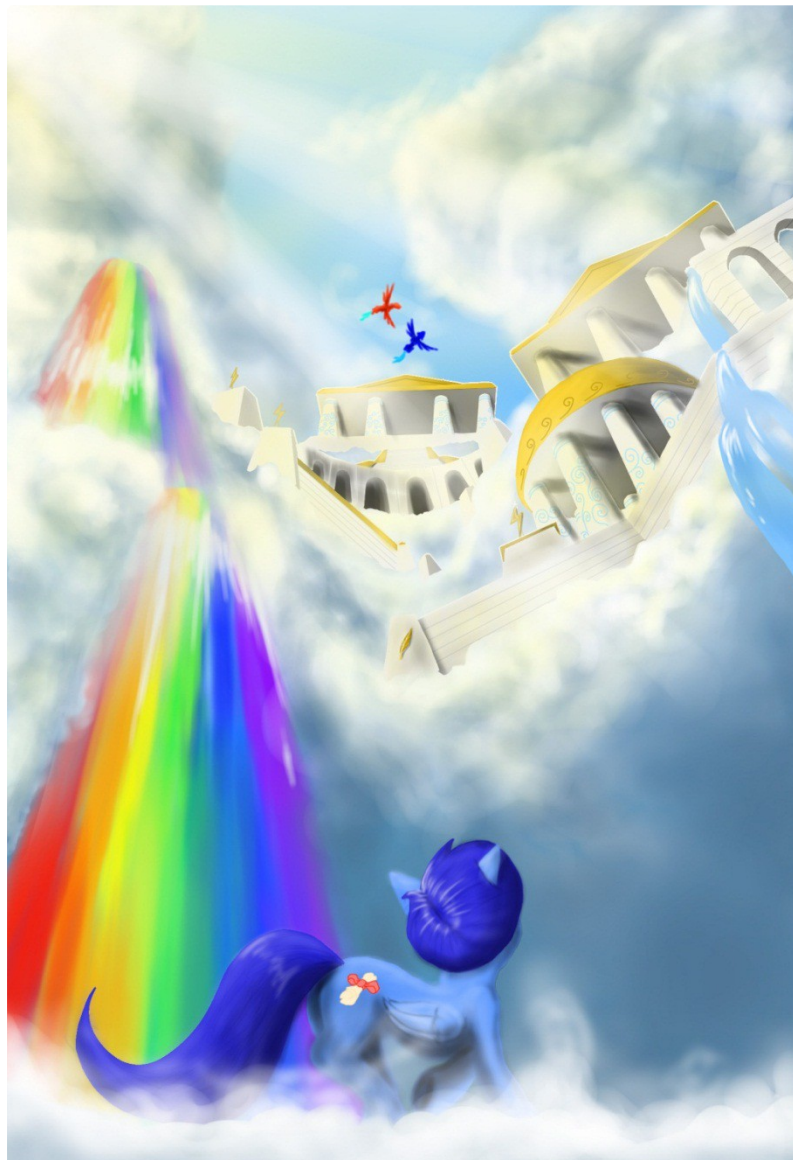

Art Show Silent Auction

This auction will run on Saturday - it is a written auction. You write the amount you want to bid. Others can write higher bids later on in the day. The highest bid written on paper wins, so if you want to win, check back often to see if anyone else wrote a higher bid for your item.

Display:

Art entered into the auction will be on display in the Autographs Room between 11:00AM to 5:30PM Saturday. Art will be cordoned off from the main area and convention goers will be permitted to look at the art. Items will be taken down at 5:30PM and stowed in the Con-Ops Staff room for safekeeping overnight.

Bidding:

Convention attendees will have the opportunity to bid on items on display. Bidders will be required to register their information (Name, Shipping Address, Means of Payment, Phone Number and e-mail address) at the Cloudsdale Congress Artist Staff table (marked table 23 on the map). Bidders will be given a random pony pseudonym to use for the silent auction. To bid, bidders will mark a sheet next to the item on display with their given pseudonym and desired bid.

The highest bid at the end of the day Saturday at 5:30PM wins the item. Winning bidders may check to see if they've won on Sunday Morning at the Staff Table in the Cloudsdale Marketplace. Winners who are not able to attend Sunday will be notified via e-mail and shipped the item. The winner of the item assumes all delivery costs.

Payment:

All payments are due at the time the winners are announced on Sunday at the Staff Artist table.

To Enter an Item:

All entries to the Art Show Silent Auction will be handled by Cloudsdale Congress Artist Staff. To enter, fill out an entry sheet at the Silent Auction Artist Table in the Cloudsdale Marketplace room (eastern, bottom corner, table #23). You will list your name, item for donation, short description of the item and suggested reserve bid. You will receive the number of your item for the auction.

Artists will be debited the winning amount minus a 5% auction fee at the end of the convention Sunday. All unused art will be returned to the artist that offered it.

Live Auction - The Cloudsdale Archives

The live auction will be an auction-house style event. Proceeds from the auction will go to help the convention cover its operating costs and any additional funds will be donated directly to the Bronies for Good charity. All donations to this auction will be handled by the Bronies for Good charity team. Items will be deposited and displayed in the western, bottom corner of the Artist Alley (Table marked #1 on the Cloudsdale Marketplace map).

Auctions will begin at 10:00AM Sunday

All items entered Saturday will be live auctioned off one at a time at 10:00AM by the Bronies for Good team in the Cloudsdale Marketplace. To bid, you must be present and able to offer an amount when an item is placed on display. When the auctioneer calls the item sold, the highest bidder will win the item.

Payment:

All payments are due at the time the winners are announced on Sunday at the Bronies for Good Charity Table.

Items won after the auction will be transferred to the Con-Ops/Staff room. After your winning transaction is verified at the Bronies for Good Charity Table, you will get a number indicating the item you won. 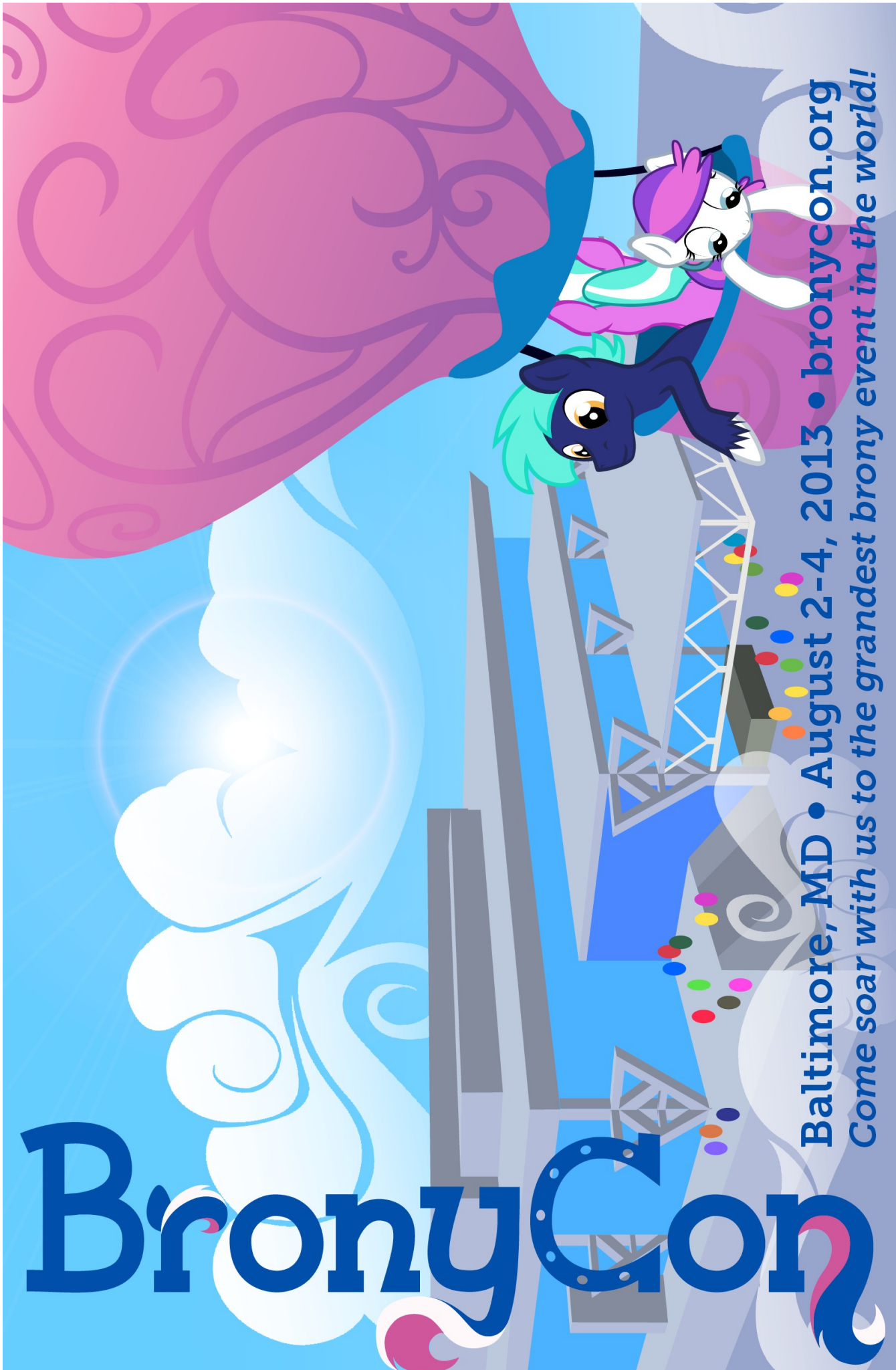


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
