Chapter 1: Editorial

In which the Guests are Welcomed in the Name of the Baron

Greetings, dear Guests! On behalf of the Baron of Blackwhite Castle, I (your most humble Master of Ceremonies) wish to welcome you to the latest festivities of furry fun and fancy frolics, also known as Eurofurence.

This year finds us back at Nuremberg, for the first time returning to a consite. And, also for the first time, we are surpassing the number of 400 guests – not without tricks and troubles though.

It will be a crowded convention even by our standards. We are no longer the small cozy gathering we once were. Eurofurence is growing, which provokes a lot of criticism. Especially regular attendees from the early days have been voicing their opinions: “It’s not what it used to be. Eurofurence has become anonymous, commercialised, too big, too loud, too expensive. And there are so many unknown faces, I don’t feel at home any more.”

Well, let me quote what an experienced manager once said to me: “A good event is doomed to become the victim of its own success.”

What does that mean? It means that those criticisms are valid. We’ve indeed lost many things over time, and there is nothing we can do about it. When 400 people want to attend, you’ll have to provide the capacity. There is no way to artificially keep a convention small. We already have a long waiting list – what would be the point in making it even longer?

Attending should not become a competition. Applying for a free space on Eurofurence should not be a race. Growth is not just an option, it is a necessity.

So, yes, in a way, Eurofurence has already become the victim of its own success. The *old* Eurofurence is no more. And it is highly unlikely that it will return.

But the “victim” metaphor is a very one-sided view on things. Firstly, the old days are not lost. If you want 100 people (or less) around a camp fire, you can still have that. There are plenty of smaller conventions following in our footsteps, and many of them are just like Eurofurence used to be five years ago.

Furthermore, we have not only been losing things. Today, we’re able to pull off some really cool stuff that would have been impossible just a few years ago – things that require manpower and money, events that were out of reach for a smaller convention. Eurofurence offers more ways to enjoy yourself than ever before. They’re just different.

So, why did I write all this? Because there is a third aspect that is special about this year’s Eurofurence: We’re outgrowing our shell. There is a certain chance that this year could be our last con in a youth hostel.

The transition to a new and different type of consite requires a lot of planning, organizational changes, and new procedures. But once again, it will also open the door to new opportunities.

Let’s look forward to all the new things that lie ahead! There’s so much to be gained! It might be fundamentally different. But it will be good!

Chapter 2: Rules of Conduct

In which Behaviour as a Gentleman is Defined, however unnecessary

Since we do, in accordance with this year's theme, expect most distinguished Ladies and Gentlemen as our Guests, it may be debatable whether it is necessary to explain proper behaviour as a Lady or Gentleman. However, over the centuries, the Castle has seen its share of ruffians and scoundrels, and we would like to show the likes of Prof. Moriarty, who may grace this festivity with a visit or not, the limits of Acceptable Conduct.

Eurofurence strives to give as many people as possible a fun time. Most of the convention is open for general audiences, except for Art Show and Dealer's Den. If you are under 18, you will only be allowed admittance to those areas or events which are appropriate for a general audience. Please always wear your badge, think of it as your admission ticket. If you fail to show your badge when security asks you to, you might be asked some uncomfortable questions.

Adult members, please be aware that minors may be present in nonrestricted areas, and consider what kind of material (comics, art, or sketchbooks for example) you want to show or pass around.

General Conduct

Eurofurence likes to present itself as a small, but professional convention. We also hope that each attendee has all the fun that our wide-ranging community can provide. Please be considerate of how your actions reflect on the convention and how they may impact or affect others.

We take pride in our appearance and we want you to as well while still having fun.

Offending newcomers, visitors and consite personnel is not appropriate, and certainly not gentlemanlike. Impressing them with how much fun and enthusiasm we have in our fandom *is*. What you consider to be acceptable behavior may not be so for others. We encourage that courtesy from all participants in our community.

Eurofurence reserves the right to exclude people from the convention on the grounds of blatant or repeated violations of the Rules of Conduct. This is not limited to incidents on the convention premises, but may as well be applied to transgressions outside of the con area. Gross misbehavior does not become acceptable just by taking it elsewhere.

Costumes and Clothing

Use your common sense in public areas inside the building, and especially when you are outside. If you have to ask or think twice about doing it in public, take it to your room. For example, kissing and holding hands, regardless of sexual orientation, is fine. Groping, tongue battles, nudity and beyond, regardless of sexual orientation, is *not*.

Remember that your personal fetish may not be appreciated by those who do not share it, and who may not want to be associated with it. If you expect respect from others – especially from people outside of the fandom –, show them respect in turn.

While collars and leashes may be worn *discreetly*, blatant displays of bondage and BDSM in public are *not* allowed.

Public exposure of genitalia, buttocks or (female) breasts is not permitted. As a rule, a minimum of a non-thong bathing suit must be worn at all times in public areas. "Anatomically correct" costumes must be likewise clothed.





It is *not* allowed to wear visible diapers or baby outfit in public, including costumes, with the possible exception of stage performance.

Security may ask you to stop an activity or to move it to a private room. Please act politely and follow those directions.

Your demeanor reflects on the fandom as a whole. Don't miss the chance to act as an ambassador of furry fandom.

Harassment and Assault

No means no. Stop means stop. Go away means go away. If someone won't understand these simple rules, contact a helpful member of security. They have the right to exclude attendees from the convention for not following these commands. Harassment is any behavior that intentionally annoys or alarms another person. This includes unwanted physical contact, following someone around in a public area without a legitimate reason, or threatening physical violence. If you are being harassed, immediately go to any member of security. The matter may be referred to the proper law enforcement authorities.

Alcohol and Parties

Eurofurence does not tolerate the serving of alcohol to minors. If you have a private party at which alcohol is served, please designate a responsible adult to not drink, so that there is a fully competent person present to deal with any emergencies that might arise.

Eurofurence does not tolerate the use of illegal substances, regardless of the circumstances.

Violation of the above rules could subject you to the *immediate* exclusion from the convention and referral of the matter to other authorities. The last thing we want is for someone attending our convention to end up in the hands of the local law enforcement authorities, in the hospital, or even worse.

Privacy and Room Sharing

While room activities can be considered private, accommodations are not off limits. Regulations regarding alcohol and drugs are still in effect. Also, please be considerate of people sharing the room with you. Space is limited – room assignment may group you with someone who does not join in, nor care much for your activities. They are guests too, so please try not to annoy them too much.

Water Pistols and Weapons

Due to the potential damage to property (of the location as well as of attendees), water guns, silly string and the like are prohibited inside the buildings of the consite. When playing outside, please do not hit any bystanders. Artists are present. Destroying original art, sketchbooks, comics, or prints is not considered funny, and will definitely limit your chances to get a free sketch. Ever.

Please note that all weapons are subject to the (rather strict) German law, from a simple knife to an elaborate broadsword, *especially* if they are bladed!

Generally all weapons must be checked by the security staff. If a weapon is part of your costume, please ask someone of our security staff to approve it. You may be asked to leave your weapon with security, or in your room, if it is deemed too dangerous to carry around.

Do not engage in swordplay or mock fights on the con premises. Have your weapon peacebound to show others that you are here to have a good time and not to behead someone, which would be most inconsiderate. If you feel the need to duel with another Gentleman, pistols at ten paces would be appropriate, but the Baron would prefer you to do it somewhere in the Scottish Highlands, where it is also easier to dispose of the bodies.

If you are performing an act on stage (or similar public display) that includes weapons





play, you *may* be allowed to draw your weapon, but you need to consult your stage manager beforehand, who will judge the possible danger of the action.

Handle your weapon, even peacebound, with the appropriate care. We do assume that, if you are carrying a weapon, you know how to behave safely. Remember that even relatively harmless items like staffs or foamcore swords can cause injuries in a crowded place. Try not to toy around with them.

Photography and Videotape

Eurofurence wants you to have great memories from a fantastic convention. Photographs and videotape footage by attendees are generally allowed in all common areas of the convention with the exception of the Art Show and Dealer's Den. Due to the nature of the event, no flash photography is allowed in the Pawpet Show. Specific rules regarding these matters may exist for other selected events.

When photographing or videotaping individuals or costumes, please use common courtesy and ask before photographing them. Please respect their rights if they do not wish to be photographed or videotaped.

Individuals may take pictures and vid-

eotapes for private viewing or sharing with friends. Photography or videography for the purpose of publication or sale to the press is expressly forbidden unless written permission has been obtained from Eurofurence e.V.

Some events will be videotaped for the purposes of producing the convention highlights video. Videotaping will also be conducted in public areas of the convention. No videotaping by convention staff will be conducted in guest rooms or in any other areas where an attendee has a reasonable expectation of privacy.

Attendees should be aware that footage gathered in public areas of the convention – including events and panels – may be used in a highlights tape, and that attendees may appear in that tape without compensation. Eurofurence will require a release only for footage that is obtained in areas that are not fully public (i.e. private functions and personal interviews.)

Should you still be in doubt now about the proper manners expected of you, just imagine what the Crown would expect from you, or better yet, ask your friendly security. And now, keep a stiff upper lip while murder and mystery unfolds around you!

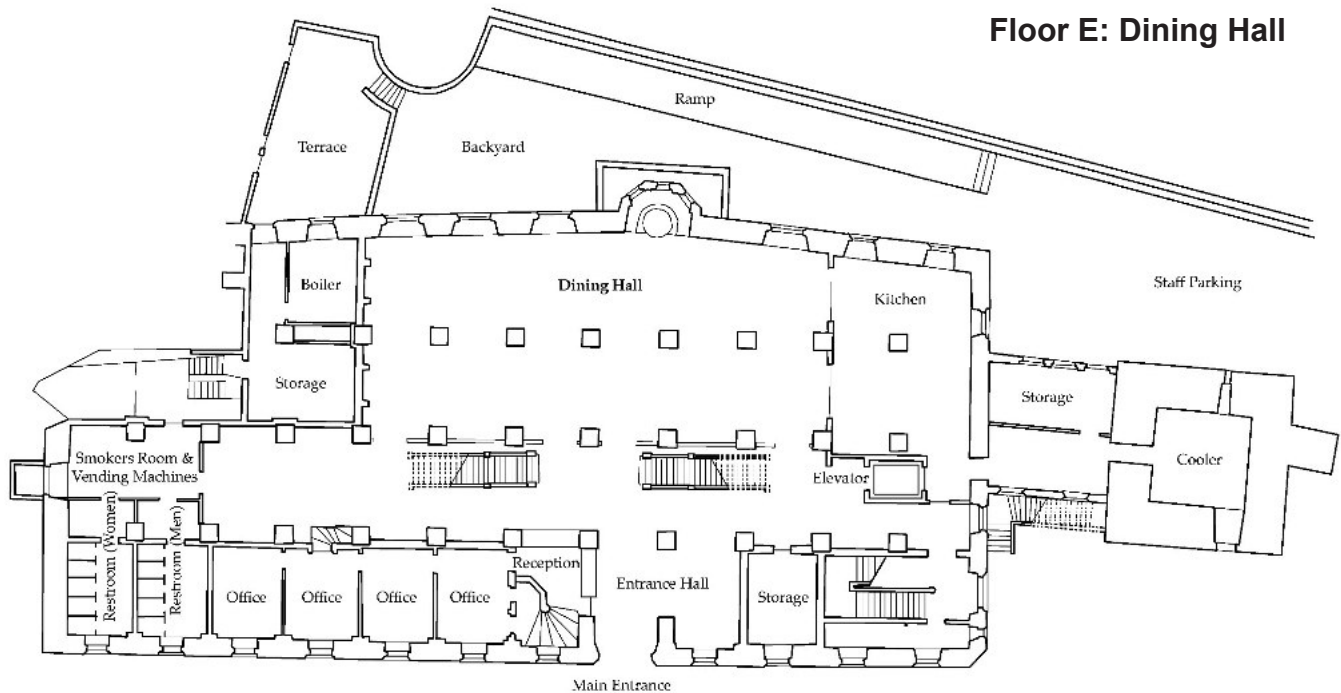
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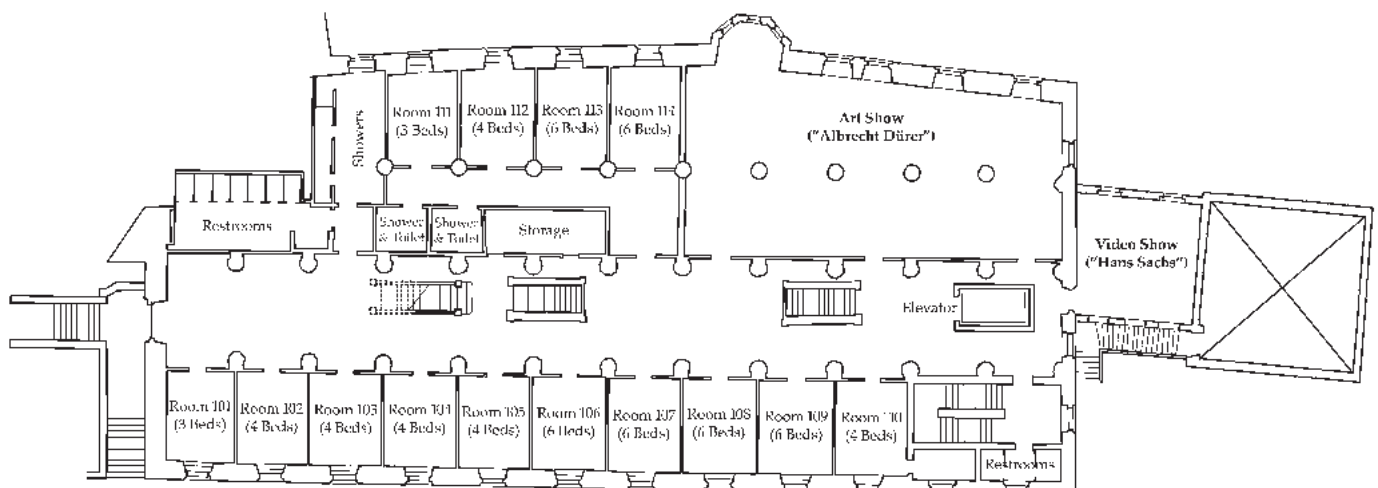

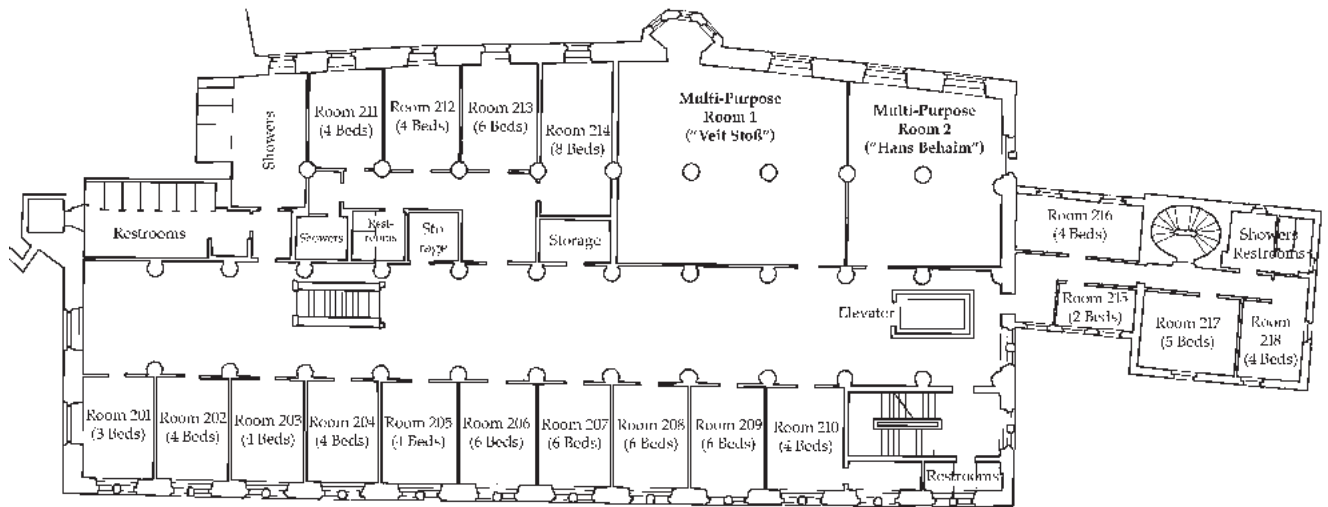


Floor 1: Art Show (Albrecht Dürer), Video Show (Hans Sachs)

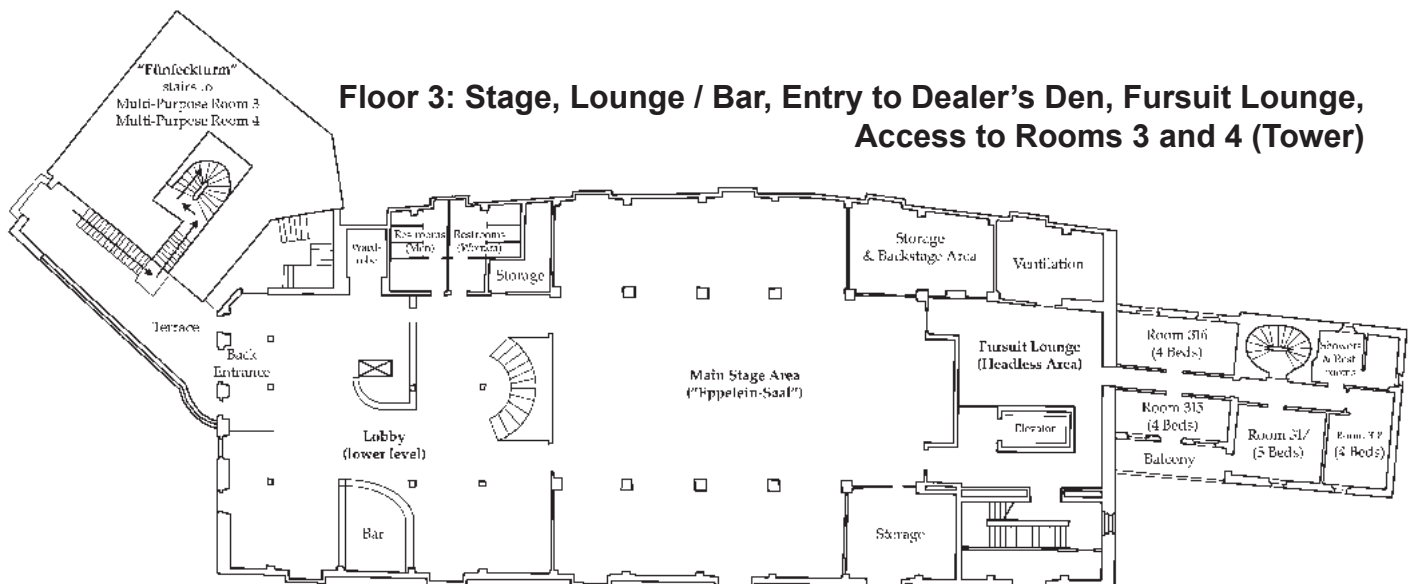




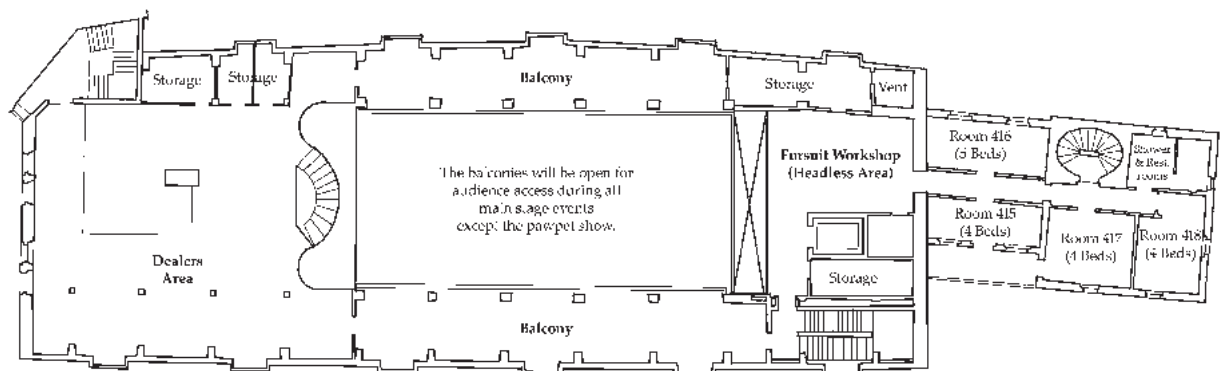
Floor 2: Room 1 (Veit Stoß) , Room 2 (Hans Beheim)

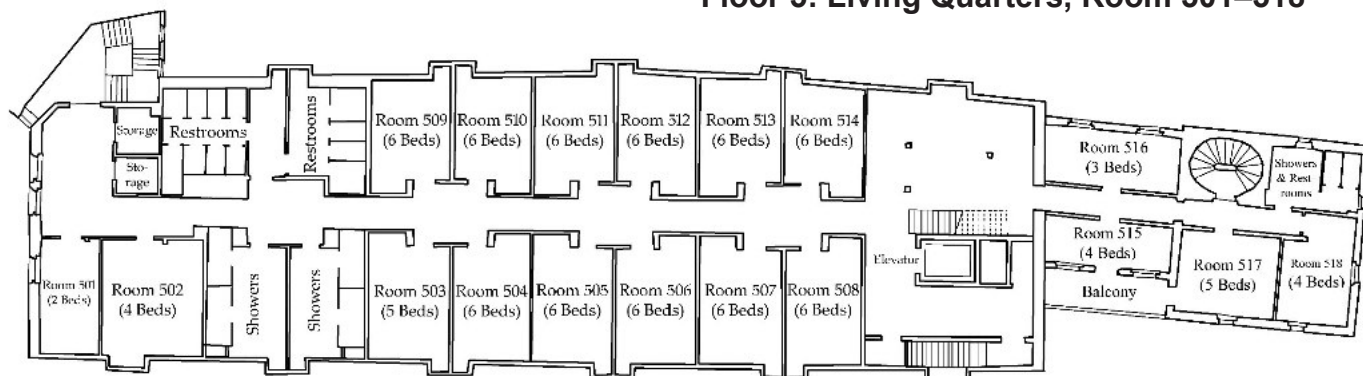


Floor 4: Dealer's Den, Fursuit Workshop, Stage Gallery

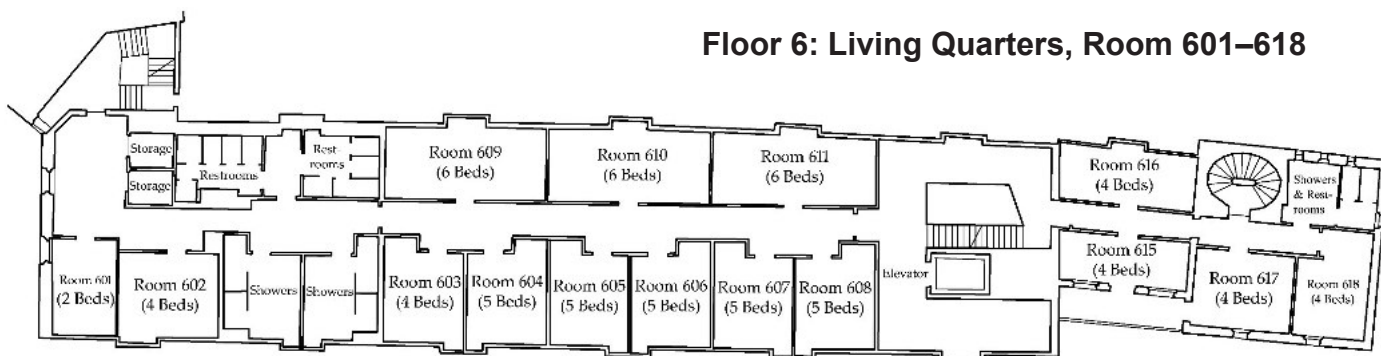




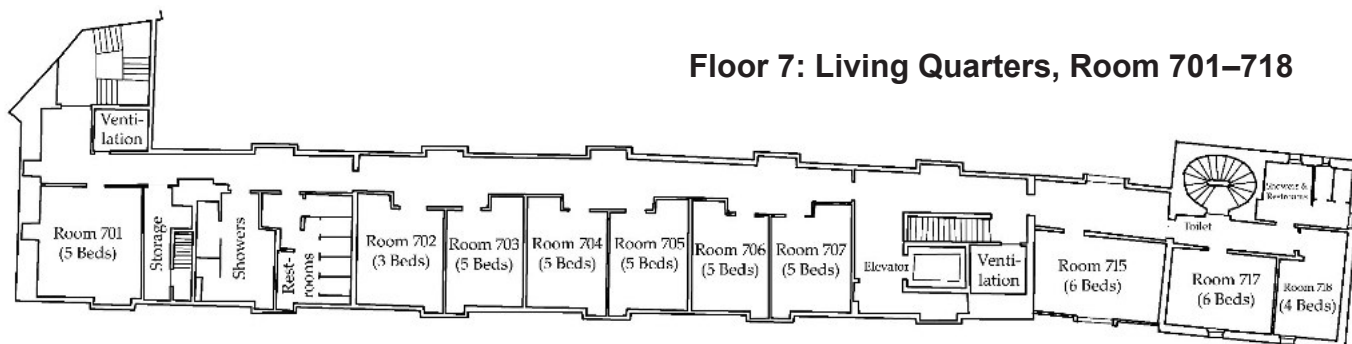
Floor 5: Living Quarters, Room 501–518

Chapter 5: All-Day Events

In which lots of fun Opportunities are Presented for All to Partake

The Murder Mystery

The main event of this year's Eurofurence is an interactive murder mystery. A murder is going to happen, potential suspects will appear and clues are going to pop up throughout the convention. In the end, the truth will come out – but **you** might be the one to find the killer.

All convention guests are invited to gather clues, talk to suspects, make theories and try to find the murderer. If you find any clues or have any ideas, feel free to talk to the Chief Detective. Starting Friday, you will also have the possibility of handing in your idea of who the killer is, along with your name and badge number, and the first one to find out the truth might even get a little reward from Scotland Yarf.

There are a few things to keep in mind concerning the murder mystery. First of all, of course, all murders are staged, so there is no need to panic or call the police. The only people relevant to the mystery are our little crew of actors, whom you will recognize by their costumes. They are the only people whose behaviour might give away clues – so please do **not** start shadowing random convention guests, because you won't get ahead with the mystery and only annoy them that way.

Also, please respect the fact that our actors are convention guests as well. They are doing this for fun, and they didn't sign on for it as a full-time job. So if you see one of the actors without their costume, this means that they are not playing their role at the moment and you should treat them just like any other congoer. You will have enough time to question the suspects and talk to the Chief Detective when they are in their role, but please respect the actors' right to have fun as regular convention

guests when they are out of their costumes by not bothering them with things pertaining to the murder mystery.

Fursuit Lounge and Workshop

The Fursuit Lounge is a place where you can cool down and go "headless" without being watched by anyone else than just fellow fursuiters, to maintain the illusion. The room is located on the 3rd floor near the elevator.

In addition, we have prepared a room for fursuit aeration, repairs, and dressing up. The Fursuit Workshop is located on the 4th floor, also near the elevator... directly above the Fursuit Lounge. Please consider the consite maps to find the Fursuit areas!

Art Show & Auction

The Art Show is open on Thursday and Friday afternoon. As usual, a large amount of artwork will not only be on display, but also for sale. You can place bids on individual pieces by putting your EF Badge number and the amount of your bid on a little piece of paper called "bidsheet", which is attached next to the piece of art being for sale. The person with the highest bid wins.

You can place bids as long as the Art Show is open. However, only a limited number of bids can be placed on the bidsheet. When all lines are full, the piece goes to the auction, which takes place on Friday evening. The Art Show will close on Friday a quarter hour after the last afternoon event, so you have time to finish bidding. Make the best out of it – but please, no unfair pouncing and warring over bids. Just send the art to auction and clear up the future ownership of the coveted piece there.



The auction is an American style auction, hosted by the incredible Uncle Kage. Bids are placed by shouting your bid amount. When no more bids are placed, the auctioneer counts “going once, going twice... SOLD!” and the piece goes to the highest bidder. Payments must be made in cash, the mandatory currency is the Euro.

Although an auction can be a lot of fun, it's still serious business: Bids are legally binding, so don't bid more than you can pay!

Art Sales (pickup and payment) takes place on Saturday in the afternoon. Don't forget to fetch your art! No one's going to carry it after you, and if you miss to pay, your art's artist will not be happy.

Dealer's Den

In ancient times, this location and event was known as Dealer's Den. Then it was rechristened Dealer's Alley due to the new layout. And this year again, we trade spaces. Is it now the Dealer's Savannah, or the Dealer's Tree Lodge? Well, let's just stick with Den again, although the lofty space is anything but a burrow.

The Dealer's Den is open from Thursday to Saturday in the afternoons, and as usual everything will be sold a furry fan's heart could wish for.

Due to popular demand, the Dealer's Den will continue for a day after the Art Auction. If you saved up for the pieces you bid on, but lost them to someone else – now's the time to return to the Dealer's Den and pick up all the stuff you thought you couldn't afford.

The Camp Fire

Having moved our convention from the great outdoors to a more urban location last year, we still have to go easy on our pyrotechnical ventures. But don't fear, we have got the per-

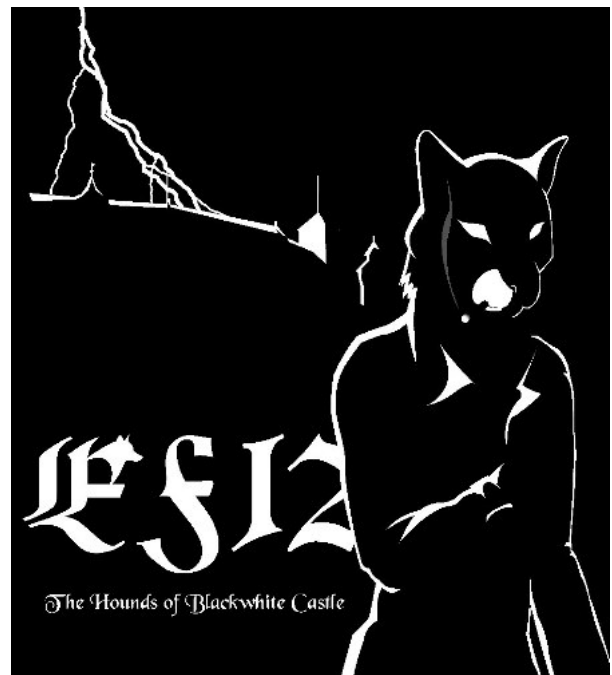
mission to put up a little fire pit outside, on the lower terrace behind the dining hall. So, if the weather permits, there'll be a nice little fire to gather around and gaze into. The fire will be put on in the late evenings.

The Con Lounge & Bar

Located in the lower lobby area of the main hall on the 3rd floor, this is meant to be one of the main areas for everyone to hang out, meet, and maybe have a drink. The bar will serve soft drinks and beer from late afternoon until midnight. The room itself will be open all day on Thursday to Saturday – look for on-site signs for changes –, including the upper terrace, a nice place to sit outside. To get there, take the stairs or the elevator to the 3rd floor, and walk across the main hall.

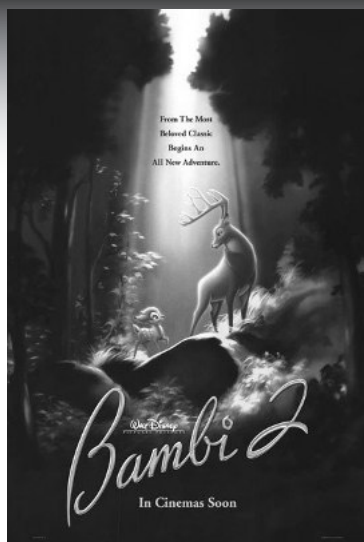
Chicken Little

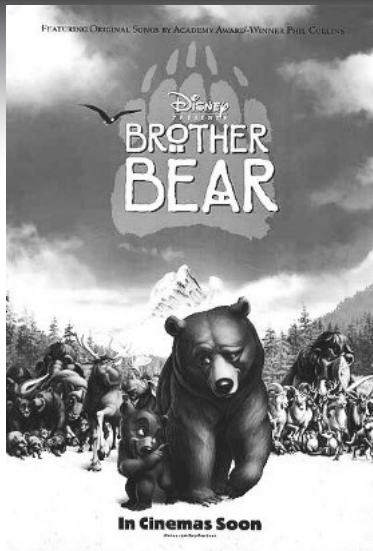
Father of the Pride

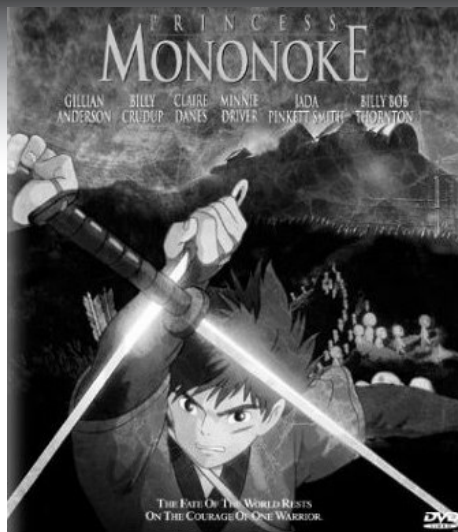


Mrs. Brisby and the Secret of NIMH

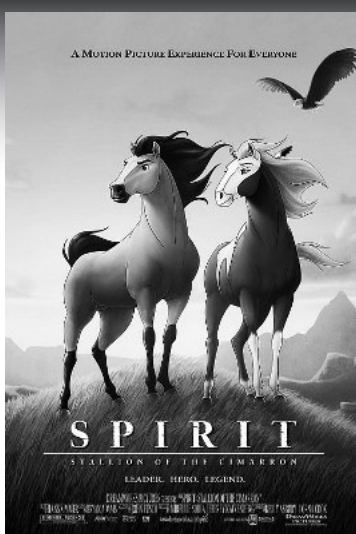
The Emperor's New Groove

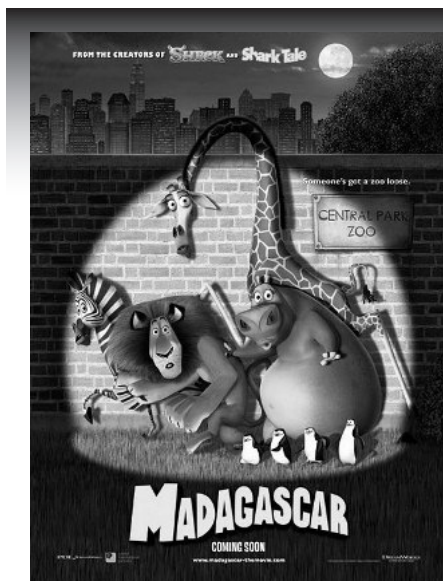
Spirit Stallion of the Cimarron

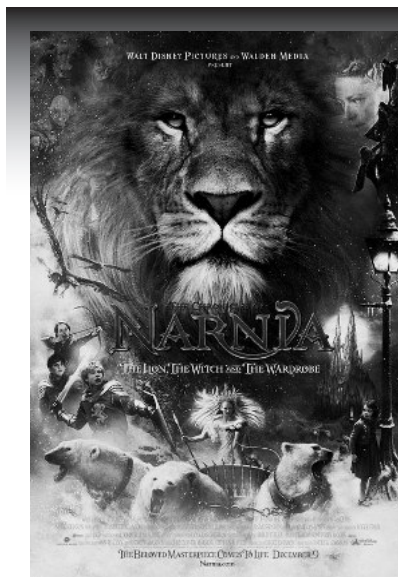


Madagascar
