Welcome to Eurofurence

This year's convention is an experiment in more than just one way. For the first time in years, we have a location outside Germany, even outside the European Union. This caused us lots of new logistical and organisational problems, and the overall attendance dropped to nearly fifty percent of last year's convention. So, will Eurofurence 9 be a failure? We sure hope not! We have toned things down a bit, hopefully making for a more personal, party-like atmosphere, and with better opportunities for relaxing and making friends. Or in short: Less emphasis on size, and more emphasis on fun!

Cunning Little Vixens

We have been searching for a motto that not only fits the furry nature of our convention, but also has some associations with the nation it is being held in, the Czech Republic.

In 1920, the popular Brno newspaper "Lidové noviny" bought a series of 200 cartoon drawings from a local artist, Stanislav Lolek, in which he told the tale of the adventures of the little Vixen Sharp-Ears. The paper's law correspondent, Rudolf Těsnohlídek, was asked to provide some text for the pictures. In that form they were issued in just over 50 installments throughout the year 1920. In 1921, when the series was complete, Těsnohlídek decided to publish the story as a novel. Marie Stejskalová, who happened to be housekeeper of world renowned composer Leoš Janáček, kept cuttings from the newspaper, and Janáček eventually found them. Janáček was so entranced, that, when the novel was later published, he adapted it into an opera script. Příhody Lišky Bystroušky, or "The Cunning Little Vixen", is now world famous.

Today, the opera is still very popular, and there has even been an animated cartoon done by the BBC about it. So what could be more fitting than dedicating this year's convention to one of the most important classic "furry" works in european history?

rules of conduct

Eurofurence strives to give as many people as possible a fun time. Most of the convention is open for general audiences, except for Art Show and Dealer's Den. If you are under 18, you will only be allowed admittance to those areas or events which are appropriate for a general audience. Please always wear your badge, think of it as your admission ticket. If you fail to show your badge when security asks you to, you might be asked some uncomfortable questions.

Adult members, please be aware that minors may be present in nonrestricted areas, and consider what kind of material (comics, art, or sketchbooks for example) you want to show or pass around.

General Conduct

Eurofurence likes to present itself as a small, but professional convention. We also hope that each attendee has all the fun that our wide-ranging community can provide. Please be considerate of how your actions reflect on the convention and how they may impact or affect others.

We take pride in our appearance and we want you to as well while still having fun. Offending newcomers, visitors and consite personnel is not appropriate. Impressing them with how much fun and enthusiasm we have in our fandom *is*. What you consider to be acceptable behavior may not be so for others. We encourage that courtesy from all participants in our community.

Costumes and Clothing

Use your common sense in public areas inside the building, and especially when you are outside. If you have to ask or think twice about doing it in public, take it to your room. For example, kissing and holding hands, regardless of sexual orientation, is fine. Groping, tongue battles, nudity and beyond, regardless of sexual orientation, is not.

While collars and leashes may be worn discreetly, blatant displays of bondage and BDSM in public are not allowed. Public exposure of genitalia, buttocks or (female) breasts is not permitted. As a rule, a minimum of a non-thong bathing suit must be worn at all times in public areas. "Anatomically correct" costumes must be likewise clothed. Security may ask you to stop an activity or to move it to a private room. Repeat offenders may be required to leave the convention.

Harassment and Assault

No means no. Stop means stop. Go away means go away. If someone won't understand these simple rules, contact a helpful member of security. They have the right to exclude attendees from the convention for not following these commands. Harassment is any behavior that intentionally annoys or alarms another person. This includes unwanted physical contact, following someone in a public area without a legitimate reason, or threatening physical violence. If you are being harassed, immediately go to any member of security. The offender may be excluded from the convention and the matter may be referred to the proper law enforcement authorities.

Alcohol and Parties

Eurofurence does not tolerate the serving of alcohol to minors. If you have a private party at which alcohol is served, please designate a responsible adult to not drink, so that there is a fully competent person present to deal with any emergencies that might arise. Eurofurence does not tolerate the use of illegal substances. Violation of the above rules could subject you to the immediate exclusion from the convention and referral of the matter to other authorities. The last thing we want is for someone attending our convention to end up in the hands of the local law enforcement authorities, in the hospital, or even worse.

Water Pistols and Weapons

Due to the potential damage to property (of the location as well as of attendees), water guns, silly string and the like are prohibited inside the buildings. When playing outside, please do not hit any bystanders. Artists are present. Destroying original art, sketchbooks, comics, or prints is not considered funny.

Generally all weapons must be checked by the security staff. If a weapon is part of your costume, please ask someone of our security staff to approve it. Even relatively harmless items like staffs can cause injuries in a crowded place. Try not to toy around with them.

Photography and Videotape

Eurofurence wants you to have great memories from a fantastic convention. Photographs and videotape footage by attendees are generally allowed in all common areas of the convention with the exception of the Art Show and Dealer's Den. Specific rules regarding these matters may exist for selected events.

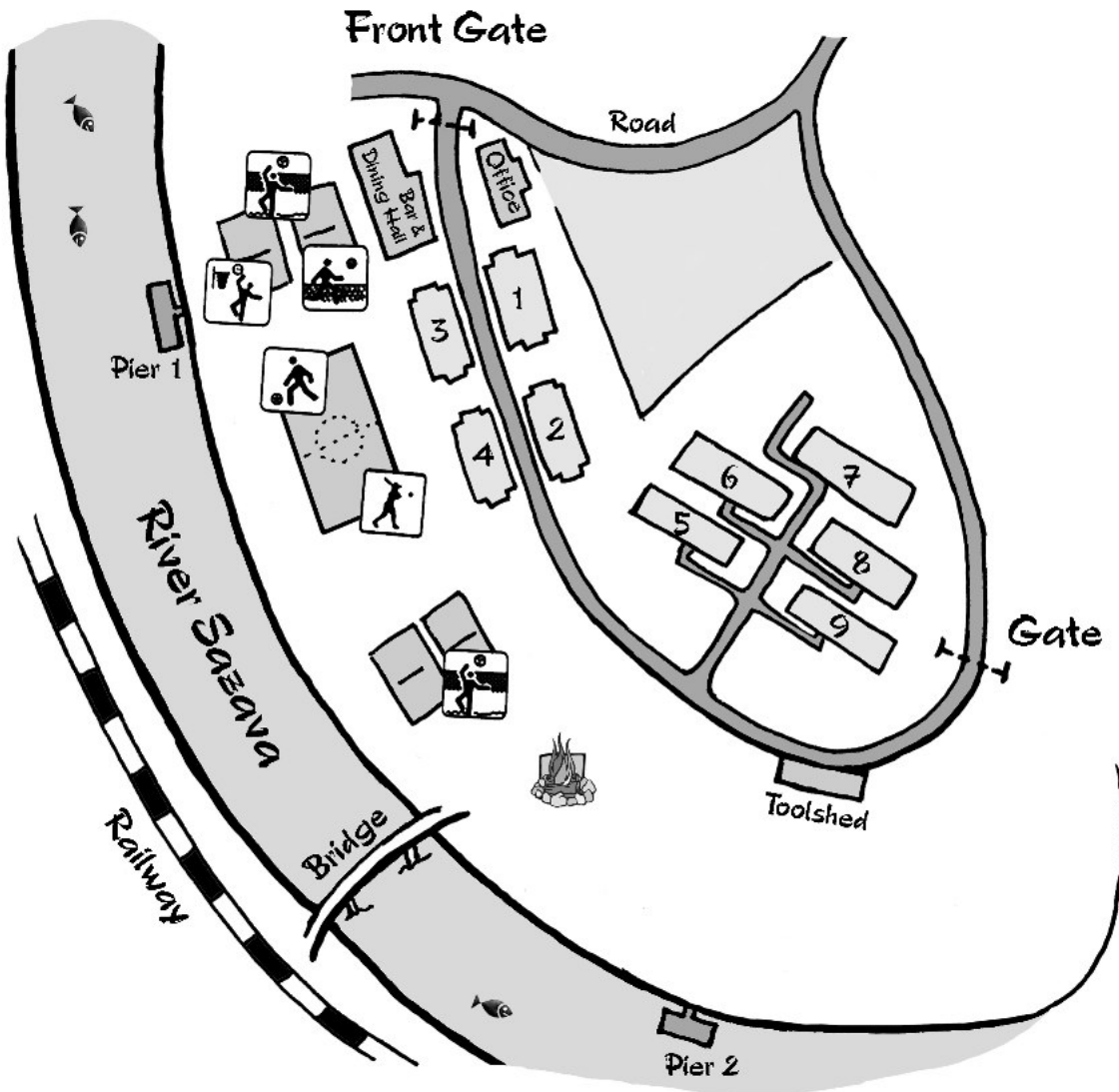
When photographing or videotaping individuals or costumes, please use common courtesy and ask before photographing them. Please respect their rights if they do not wish to be photographed or videotaped.

Individuals may take pictures and videotapes for private viewing or sharing with friends. Photography or videography for the purpose of sale or publication to the press is expressly forbidden unless written permission has been obtained from Eurofurence e.V.

Some events will be videotaped for the purposes of producing the convention highlights video. Videotaping will also be conducted in public areas of the convention. No videotaping by convention staff will be conducted in guest rooms or in any other areas where an attendee has a reasonable expectation of privacy.

Attendees should be aware that footage gathered in public areas of the convention – including events and panels – may be used in a highlights tape, and that attendees may appear in that tape without compensation. Eurofurence will require a release only for footage that is obtained in areas that are not fully public (i.e. private functions and personal interviews.)

The forest is teeming with busy life.



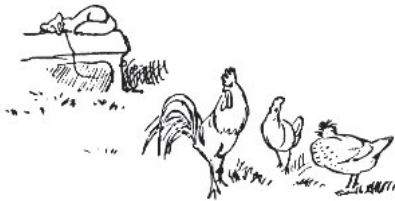
Bartoš the forester catches a young vixen and takes her home.

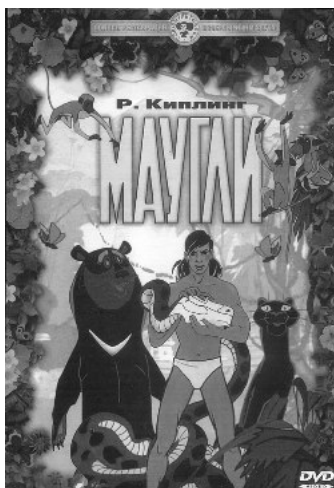

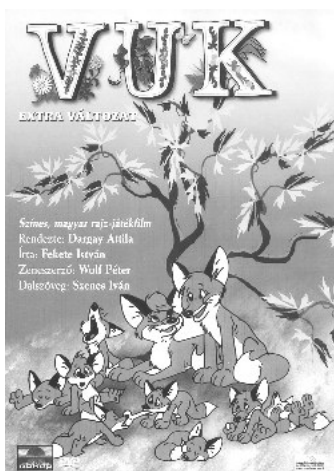
MAYTIN, USSR, 1973 (Russian / English subtitles) 96 min

Almost everyone has read or at least heard of the Jungle Books, written by Rudyard Kipling more than a century ago, which tell a tale of a human child, adopted and raised by a family of wolves and growing up in the jungle with his animal friends. Facing many challenges and dangers, he eventually grows into the master of the jungle – until one day he returns to live with the humans. Maugli, a series of animated movies produced by Soyuzmultfilm in the USSR in 1973, is very different from Disney standard, but still done with great care. It no longer shows the jungle as a big party, but as a place of wonder and hidden beauty.

Vuk

Hungary, 1981 (English / No subtitles) 76 min

Vuk, a little fox, is living with his family in a forest. Being the liveliest of the litter, he heads out for an early exploration journey – but returns to find his family killed by a hunter and his dogs. Adopted and raised by an old fox named Karak, he grows to avenge his family and fulfill the meaning of his name: Vadaszom, Utambol Kotrodj! (Out of my way, hunter!) The animated movie was directed by Attila Dargay, based on a book by Istvan Fekete, written in 1965. A lovely and inspiring movie, which many furries fondly remember from their youth.



Minusch

Minoes, Netherlands, 2001 (German / No subtitles) 86 min

The cat Minoes turns into a young woman (while retaining some of her feline characteristics) and helps Tibbe, the journalist, to gather news for the front page of a local newspaper. With the help of Minoes, who can talk to the cats in the small town, he soon discovers that the helpful and popular chairman of the “Club For Friends of Animals” and boss of a nearby factory has evil plans with the village. Minoes is a sweet, amusing movie, with very nice special effects/animation, lots of humor and even some rather thrilling scenes.

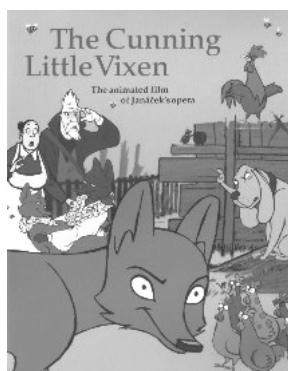


Ice Age

USA, 2002 (English / No subtitles) 81 min

20,000 years ago, Earth is entering an ice age. All kinds of animals begin migrating to the south, except Sid the sloth who is left behind sleeping. Awaking, he meets Manny, a solitary mammoth who travels to the north. When a humans camp is attacked by tigers, a baby is rescued by Manny and Sid. The two animals decide to return the baby to its father. But Diego, one of the tigers that attacked the humans, also comes to claim the baby. Directed by Chris Wedge, who had earlier won an Academy award for his short movie “Bunny”.

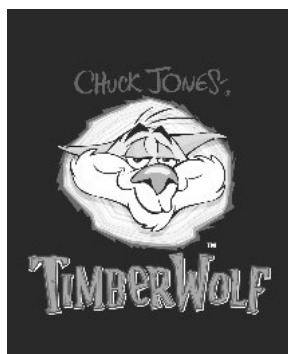




The cunning little Vixen

UK, 1996 (English / No subtitles) 60 min

It is probably the only opera to have been taken from a run of daily cartoons, though the idea of Fred Basset, Garfield or Snoopy suddenly springing into operatic life is an appealing ring of changes from the usual melodrama. Geoff Dunbar has taken Janáček's lead and turned The Cunning Little Vixen into an animated film. What Geoff Dunbar is afforded in his choice of medium is a more vivid portrayal of the animals behaviour (which will almost certainly be a hit with adults and children alike), with a heavy dose of humour.



Thomas Timberwolf (Episode 1-13)

USA, 2002 (English / No subtitles) 65 min

Created and produced by Academy Award winning animation director Chuck Jones. Chuck Jones, who died in February 2002, was an American artist and director of animated films, most memorably for the Warner Brothers movie studio. One of his last works was the creation of new cartoons for the Internet based on his new character... Thomas Timberwolf.



Nu Pogodi! (Episode 1-12)

Hy, погоди! USSR (Russian / No subtitles) 90 min

Funny adventures of an inseparable couple – hooligan Wolf and clever Hare. Beautifully created pictures brought many years of popularity to this animated series, to which the soviet animator Viacheslav Kotenochkin devoted 20 years of his life. We present you 12 episodes of the Russian version of Tom and Jerry in original Russian version with no subtitles. Before you panic, repeat after me: Nu, pogodi! – Just you wait! If you can learn this phrase, following the episodes will be no problem for you, even if you don't understand a word of Russian.



Wolf's Rain (Episode 1-4)

Japan, 2003 (Japanese / English subtitles) 90 min

In a world of the distant future where wolves are thought to be extinct, a legend claims that when the world reaches its end, a paradise will appear somewhere, but only the wolves will know where to find it. In truth, nature has granted the wolves the ability to appear in human form in order to avoid total extinction. Together, they are trying to find paradise and avoid being hunted by a man named Quent Yaiden, who seeks vengeance on all wolves.



Spirit - Stallion of the Cimarron

USA, 2002 (English / No subtitles) 86 min

Curiosity leads Spirit, a freeborn stallion of the Old West, into the hands of soldiers who are determined to break his will. But he escapes captivity, befriends a beautiful mare and creates a lasting friendship with a Native American. On the long trail back to his herd, he is confronted with the soldiers again, and with the prospect that the carefree paradise of his birthland may soon be lost. The animation is a seamless mix of traditional cel animation, and computer generated imagery.

The consite is covered by WiFi wireless network connected to the Internet.

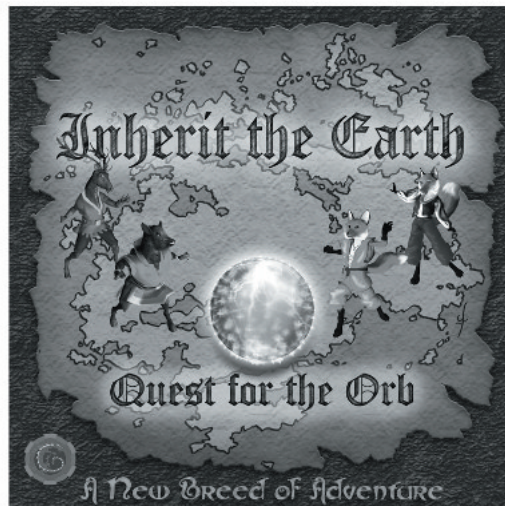
How to connect: Set network name to "ALTAIRCOM" (without quotes, all uppercase letters). There is no WEP key or whatever else, let everything set to automatic.
