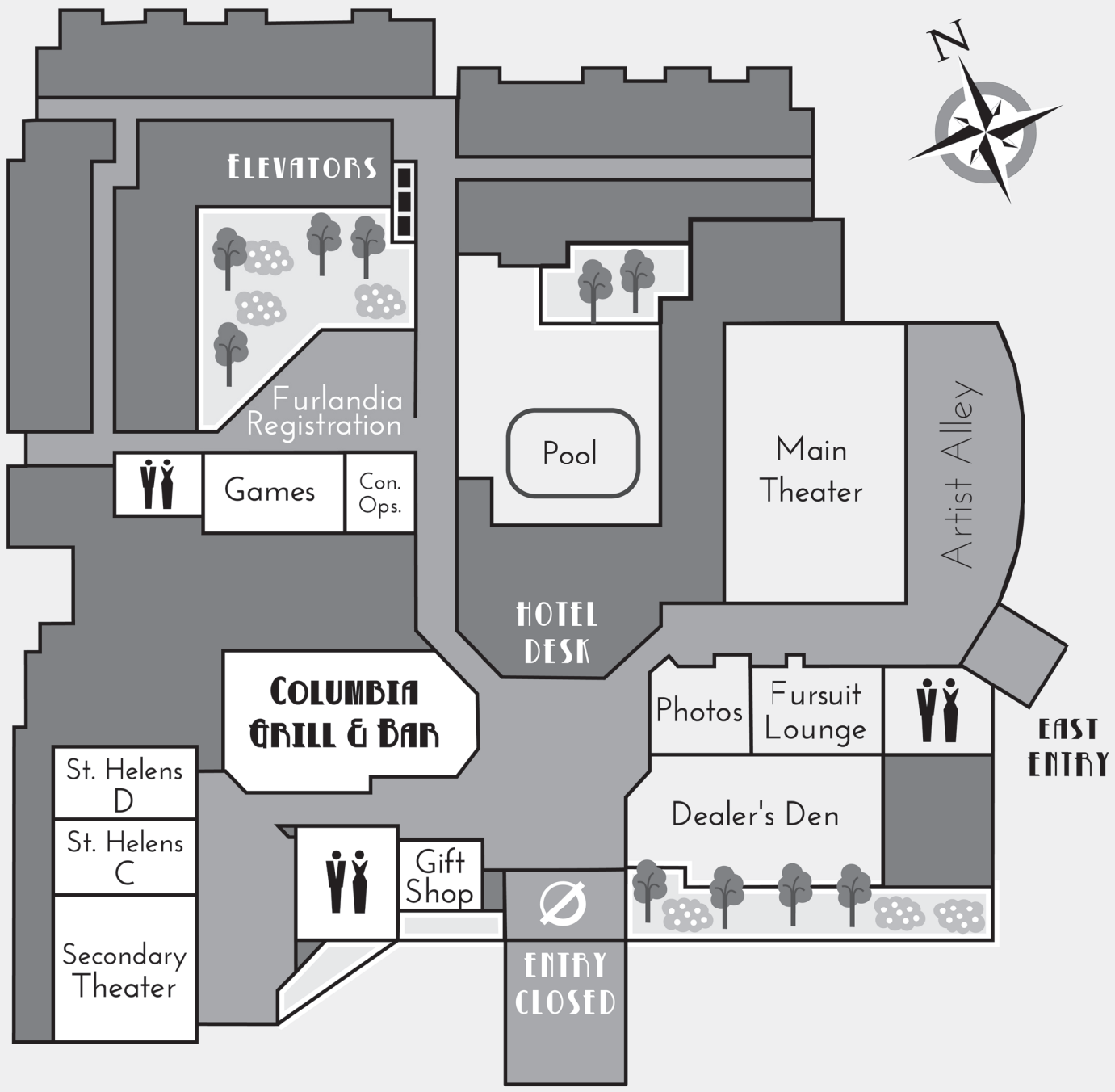


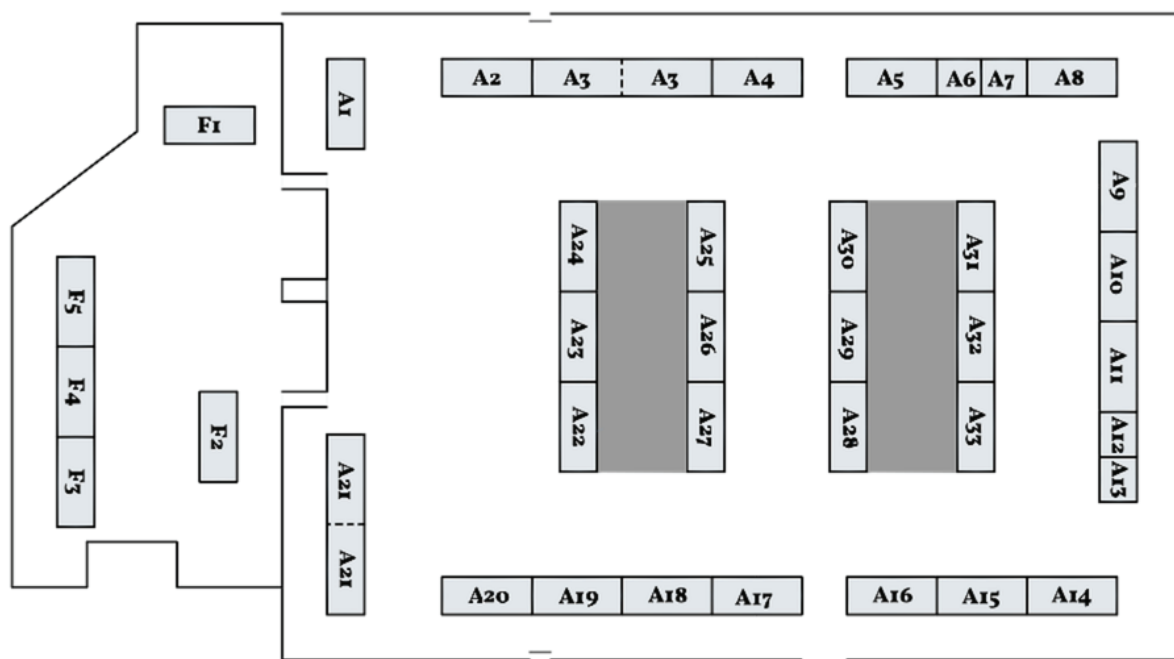

He has performed and composed for numerous acts and media. As a composer, he has worked for Supervillain Studios with their Nintendo Wii production Order Up! He has also composed for Gamer Tonight, an acclaimed comedy video game parody show, as well as various media and commercial products.

Jumpiicat



Becoming entranced with the dirty house sounds of the mid 2000s, the rough and euphoric sounds of classic hardstyle in 2009, and later the thumping jump/tek and freestyle beats of the current day, DJ Jumpiicat has always had a taste for something different. Honing his skills in recent years, he's done varying gigs ranging from basketball halftime shows, to weddings, to barbeques and beyond, typically playing pop/house and indie dance hits. Animal Aid

Furlandia may be the name of this convention, but as the staff and volunteers of Animal Aid can attest, there's a whole other land of fur to be discovered at Animal Aid's shelter, where cats like Paulette and Ringo (pictured) enjoy all the comforts of home while waiting for their forever families to find them.

"At Animal Aid, we view the animals as our clients, so their needs always come first," said Director of Operations Paige O'Rourke.

A nonprofit, no-kill organization, Animal Aid was founded in 1969 by Portland radio personality Jack Hurd, who spoke on air about the number of cats that were abandoned near his home in Laurelhurst Park and how much this bothered him and his wife, Kathryn. When Jack's listeners heard about the problem, they called in to talk about their own animal-related

issues. Many people told stories of their sick or injured pets and how they could not afford the necessary veterinary care. Jack realized that something needed to be done to help these people and their animals. It was then that the concept of "Animal Aid" was born, with the mission to reduce animal suffering by providing assistance to abused, homeless, injured, and sick animals.

Flash forward to today, and Animal Aid now has a facility in SW Portland equipped with a free-roaming shelter for cats and a foster program for cats and dogs. Beyond this, Animal Aid's programs include the Animal Aid Cares Fund, a partnership with local veterinarians to provide emergency medical funding for pet owners in need; Canine Spay/Neuter in Portland (C-SNIP), a partnership with PAW Team to provide financial assistance for the spay/neuter of pets of the homeless or those living in extreme poverty; and Heartstrings, a program that ensures that longtime residents of the shelter—who many times are senior

or “special needs” cats and dogs—get the best possible care while at the shelter or with a foster.

“I chat up Animal Aid to everyone I know,” Animal Aid volunteer Susan Brown Philbeck said. “Whether they are looking to adopt or know someone who is, or if they are interested in volunteering, I tell them how rewarding it is, how much fun they will have, how much they will enjoy the staff and volunteers, what an outstanding shelter it is regarding the excellent health care provided for all our animals, how clean it is, and how diligently we look for the very best match for each cat or dog—I think we pay more attention to that than just about any other shelter.”

DONATE TO ANIMAL AID TODAY

Since 1969, Animal Aid has helped tens of thousands of animals in need. Our work is only made possible by your generous support. Here are some examples of what your donations will provide the animals in our care:

\$60 will provide a month of food and litter for a cat

\$150 will provide a specialist exam for an advanced health issue

The Animal Aid Cares Fund (formerly known as the Animal Aid Fund for Urgent Veterinary Care) was established to help those who are facing urgent and overwhelming veterinary expenses without the means to pay for them. Animal Aid partners with veterinary offices in Portland to offer financial support, and the veterinary office provides discounted rates and facilitates the grant appointments from the fund.

In 2014, Animal Aid expanded the program to incorporate the Helping Hands fund, which was developed to support animals adopted from the shelter who have health or behavioral conditions that make their adoptions more financially challenging. The Helping Hands fund can assist with medications, training, or unexpected medical treatment. 100% of the program’s funds go directly to paying veterinary bills or providing training.

Canine Spay/Neuter in Portland (C-SNIP) is a collaboration between Animal Aid and PAW Team (Portland Animal Welfare Team) aimed at making affordable canine spay/neuter available to homeless and extremely low-income Portland-area residents. Both Animal Aid and PAW Team believe that while spaying and neutering should be the norm at all economic levels, there are compelling reasons to focus now on the pets of people living in extreme poverty. These folks are struggling for the essentials and have little or no money for veterinary care of any kind. There are three communities that will benefit greatly from C-SNIP: the animals themselves, the homeless and low-income people who are their guardians, and the greater community.

FURLANDIA CODE OF CONDUCT

General Conduct

Please use common sense and respect others' right to enjoy the event. Remember that any activity which is illegal by municipal, county state, or Federal statute, law, or regulation outside the event is illegal during event. Event staff will ask you to stop an illegal activity. If the illegal activity continues, event staff will report this activity to hotel security and other proper authorities. While in public or in convention spaces, attendees are expected to maintain a "PG-13" standard of conduct. Repeat offenders may have their membership revoked. Please also note that the event staff retains the right to deny entry to anyone and that you can be asked to leave at any time without warning or particular infraction to these stated rules of conduct.

Badging Policy

Furlandia ensures that each member gets both a lanyard and at least one type of membership badge. Your 'proof of membership' is defined as both a current year lanyard, and any badge issued to you by the convention for the current year. You must be visibly wearing 'proof of membership' at all times during our event, and you understand that event staff can request to see proof of membership at any time. Event staff may deny you access to events or event space if you do not have 'proof of membership'. All Furlandia issued badges remain the property of RAIn for the duration of the convention and must be surrendered upon request.

Identification policy

While in the event space, all attendees (in and out of costume) are required to have their con badge clearly visible at all times. The event badge must not be obscured by custom or bespoke badges, and must remain outward facing so the badge color code and name are visible.

Occasionally the hotel staff will ask for costumers to "lift your head" when ordering food, requesting services or communicating with hotel staff. The hotel policy regarding costumes is no head coverings, so the Sheraton Portland Airport Hotel is being very generous by allowing costumers, fursuiters, and others.

Media Policy

As per our policy, the staff has decided not to allow ANY media coverage at the event without PRIOR approval. Attendees purchasing a membership agree not to act as media agents in any way, shape, or form while attending our event. Making photographic, audio, or video recordings of any convention event for investigative or commercial purposes is strictly forbidden.

Hotel

As a convention attendee, you are a guest of the hotel and must abide by the hotel's rules and policies whenever you are on the premises. However, if you are unsure if something is allowed, Hotel Front Desk will be able to assist you. If you are expelled from the hotel for violation of their rules, you immediately forfeit your event membership and must surrender your 'proof of membership'. You are responsible for any damage you cause to hotel property. The event space and public spaces of the hotel may not be used as sleeping areas.

Dress code

Hotel dress code is all visitors to the hotel in common areas (e.g. lobby and hotel corridors) must be covered from shoulders to thighs. Swimming pool area is the only exception to this rule. Violations of this policy will result in no access to the event space.

No shoe policy

Hotel policy is shoes are required while in common areas (e.g. lobby, ground floor corridors). No shoes, no service—no access to the event space.



FURLANDIA CODE OF CONDUCT

Harassment and Assault

Harassment is defined as any behavior that alarms or intentionally annoys another person. This includes making any unwanted physical contact, following someone around a public area without a legitimate reason, or threatening to physically attack someone. Please remember that if you approach someone and they tell you “no” or to leave them alone, your business with them is done. If you do not leave them alone as they have requested, your actions may be grounds for a complaint of harassment. If you feel that you are being harassed, or you have been assaulted, please report the matter immediately to event staff.

Weapons

Bladed weapons (such as daggers or swords) and toy firearms are acceptable provided they have been peace bonded such that they clearly cannot be drawn. Water guns and Silly String type products of any kind are NOT acceptable due to the potential for damage to costumes, hotel property, ect. “If it is drawn, you’re gone”. Any drawing, open carry (of firearms), displaying, brandishing, or making any threatening gesture with any weapon or firearm, both real and replica, shall be cause for immediate expulsion from the event. The only exception to this shall be at a prearranged demonstration or event with the permission of the event coordinators.

Under-age Members

Minors under the age of 13 shall be accompanied by a parent, legal guardian, or an adult designated as responsible by their parent or guardian at all times. For minors from age of 13 to 17, there must be a responsible adult on site and able to be contacted at all times. All minors under the age of 17 must have a parent or legal guardian present at all times in convention designated areas (ie headless lounge).

Minor Curfew

All attendees under the age of 18 must be out of any convention designated area after 9 PM. Any minors who are in said designated space after 9 PM do so without the expressed consent of Furlandia and Furlandia staff.

Violations and Appeals

Violations of these policies will be handled by event staff as deemed appropriate. Violators will be asked to cease and desist. Violators may have their membership revoked and a 390 day ban placed. Two members of the executive committee (one of whom must be the Convention Chair or Vice-Chair) are required in order to revoke a membership. Membership revocations are final, however a ban may be appealed to the RAIIn Board of Directors. Decisions made by the majority of Board of Directors are final.



FURLANDIA DRESS CODE

ALL VISITORS TO THE HOTEL IN COMMON AREAS (E.G. LOBBY AND HOTEL CORRIDORS) MUST BE COVERED FROM SHOULDERS TO THIGHS.

SWIMMING POOL AREA IS THE ONLY EXCEPTION TO THIS RULE.

VIOLATIONS OF THIS POLICY WILL RESULT IN NO ACCESS TO THE EVENT SPACE.

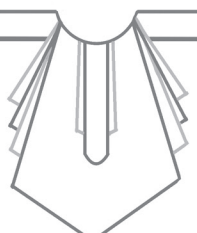

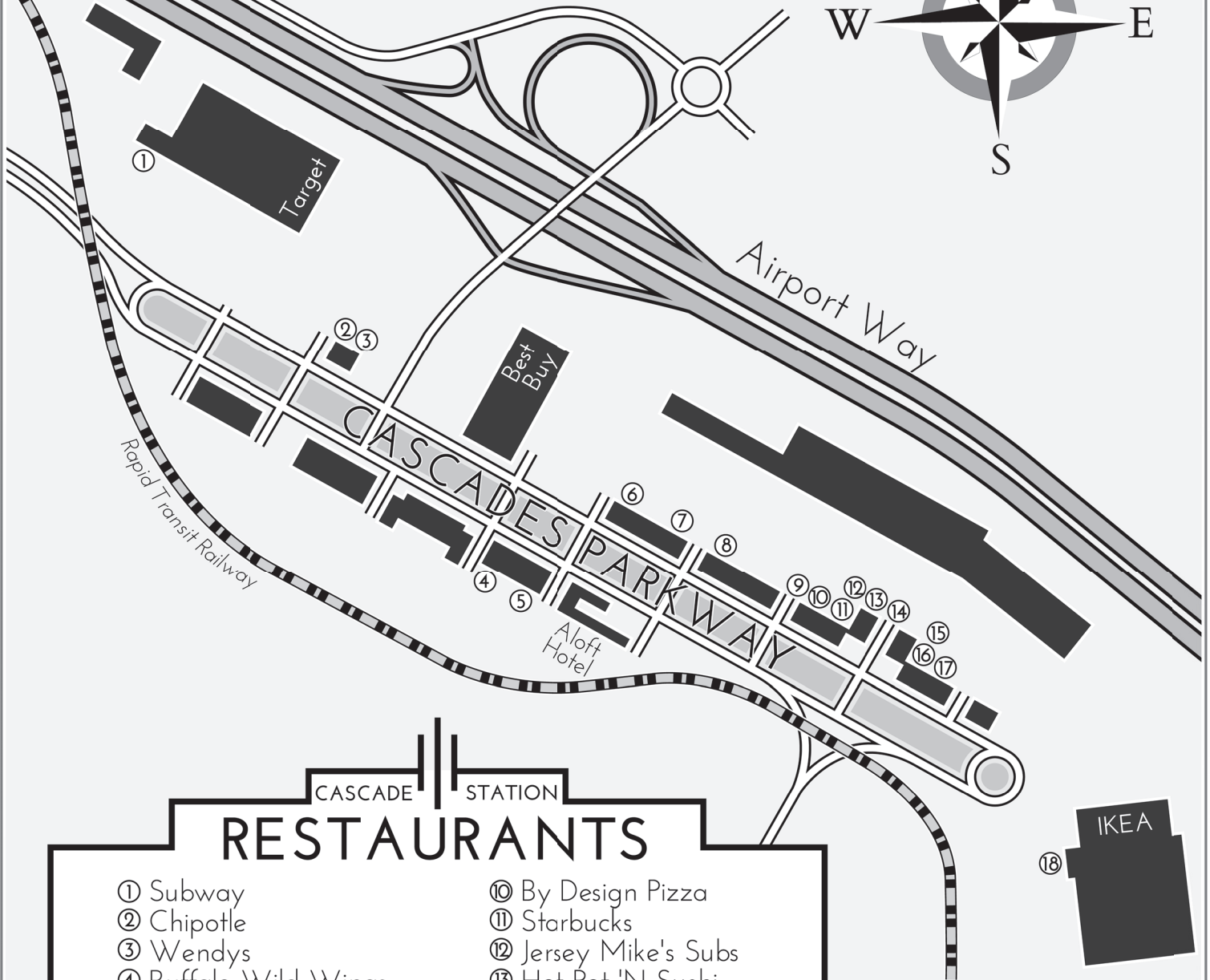
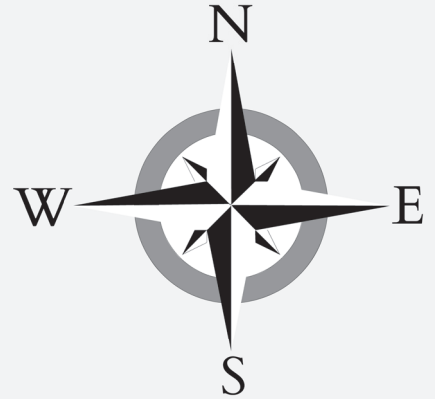
