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Rules and Emergency Behaviour

Preamble

- These rules are in full effect inside the entire venue area of GalaCon.
- The domiciliary rights of the venue staff even stands above the convention rules.

Security / Emergency

- What staff says counts. You are expected to adhere to all orders given by the convention- and the venue staff as well as the volunteers.
- If you ever find yourself in a bind, don't hesitate to ask the staff for help. Don't try to solve a heated situation on your own! If in doubt let the guards or other staff take care of it instead.
- Emergency exits are to be kept usable at all times. Don't get in the way of volunteer work and medical assistance.
- In case of fire go to the marked rescue area and listen to the volunteers and fire fighters. Never try to extinguish fire on your own.
- Do not harass, ridicule or bully guests or staff.
- Do not approach the Guests of Honour in their downtime. They need their rest just like you do, so please, give them space!
- Animals are not allowed. Only exception are guide dogs and similar pets that you depend on for your wellbeing. All other animals will be removed by the local police or animal welfare on your bill if needed. Please save your pet friends the pain and leave them at home!
- Do not camp at the venue.
- Depictions and symbols that are prohibited by German law are strictly forbidden (an example would be world war related imagery, e.g. Swastikas). If you wear, draw or show content with such depictions you will be removed from the convention.
- Use the trash bins! They are there for a reason. Cleaning up behind yourself is important. If you don't clean up on your own, volunteers will order you to do so.
- All kinds of skates are only allowed for photos. You're not allowed to actually use them as a means of getting around the con.

Weapons

- All kinds of harmful weapons are prohibited.
- All replica weapons are prohibited.
- Soft air guns, blunted swords, anything explosive, brass knuckles, knives or any other weapons which can inflict serious pain are prohibited.
- Spike collars and bracelets are only allowed if the spikes are shorter than 5cm / 2 inches and blunt.
- LARP weapons, foam weapons and any other weapons meant for safe usage have to be revised by the GalaCon staff. If we approve them they get marked. Unmarked weapons will be confiscated.
- If you break a weapon rule and bring a dangerous weapon into the venue, it's possible that you will be removed by the police AND charged for violating German weapon laws. You can be fined at least 10.000 € for this, so seriously, don't do it.

Keep calm and Gala on

Youth Protection

- All visitors must carry valid ID at all times.
- The convention staff can request to see your ID at any time.
- Valid means of ID: Official ID-Card, Passport or Driver's license.
- Other documents are NOT valid and will not be accepted!
- All visitors up to the age of 12 can enter GalaCon for free.
- Up to the age of 14 visitors must be accompanied by a parent or legal guardian.
- Visitors under the age of 16 not accompanied by a parent or legal guardian must leave the con area at 10pm.
- Alcohol and smoking inside the venue is forbidden at all times. Smoking is ONLY allowed at the marked smoking areas. Drunk visitors will be removed from the convention.
- All kinds of hookahs are prohibited.
- Electronic cigarettes are only allowed outside.

Food and Drink regulations

- You are not allowed to bring food from outside the venue. Everything bought outside the venue has to be consumed outside.
- Exceptions from food are snacks. This includes fruits, candy bars, bonbons or chips.
- You are allowed to bring and carry water and juices with you in the venue. Sodas and soft drinks can be bought at the venues snack point.
- NO FOOD AND SOFTDRINKS allowed in the Theatersaal (Main Hall).

- The terrace site belongs to the KUBUS restaurant. Only food and drinks purchased there may be consumed in that area.

Recording of Film- and Photo footage

- Throughout the whole convention weekend our internal documentation and streaming teams will record film and photo footage of the event.
- Be aware that when our teams record crowded scenes or panels, you might get filmed or photographed unnoticed. The GalaCon team has the rights to publish this footage at any given time.
- If you notice this and don't want to be in the pictures and/or videos, please stand back and avoid entering the scene.
- If our team films / pictures single persons or small groups, they will ask for your permission. It is your right to disagree being filmed or pictured respectively stepping out from the picture or scene in that case.
- If you don't veto on this subject clearly, you silently agree to being filmed/pictured and the recorded footage being published at any time.

Daniel Ingram

Composer and Songwriter

He is the man who makes our little ponies - and us - sing and lets us smile smile smile on a regular basis. Besides writing songs he is also a composer who wrote scores for lots of other shows and television productions ranging from Rock to Pop right to Musical style numbers. But not only do we praise his work, Daniel Ingram also won several awards for some of his tracks.

Respectively he got nominated for one of the most important awards in television business: The Daytime Emmy. Even the famous music magazine "Rolling Stone" reported on his musical contribution on "Friendship is Magic".



Jayson and Jocelan Thiessen

Jayson Thiessen (Television Series Director / Co-Executive Producer / Animator)

Raised in western Canada on a healthy cartoon diet of Looney Tunes, Disney and 80's Saturday morning shows, his love of the animated medium spawned a desperate desire to draw and create silly cartoon ideas and characters. He has worked in the Vancouver animation industry since 1998. Starting as a classical animator, then transitioning to digital Flash animation and working his way up the ranks to become a director. In 2009 he took on the role of Supervising Director for the latest incarnation of the Hasbro series "My Little Pony: Friendship is Magic". In 2012, Jayson directed the spinoff My Little Pony movie "Equestria Girls". He was later elevated to Co-Executive Producer on the series and continues to direct the latest season. He also appears as a guest speaker at various fan and industry conventions where he talks about his experiences and expertise in animation production and directing.

Jocelan Thiessen (Animator / Layout & Storyboard Artist)

Born in Vancouver BC Canada, she went to Capilano college for animation and has been working in the Vancouver industry since 2003. She has worked as an animator, layout artist, and storyboard artist. She has storyboarded on Pucca, George of the Jungle, My Little Pony (including season 5), and Littlest Pet Shop. Her favourite parts of storyboarding are song sequences. She is responsible for MLP songs such as "Winter wrap up", "At the Gala", "Becoming popular" and designed the stop motion felt sequence in "A Friend in Deed".

Tabitha St. Germain

Original voice of Rarity, Princess Luna, Granny Smith & more

Tabitha St. Germain is an award-winning Canadian stage actress. She began working in animation in Toronto providing the voices for Kootie Pie Koopa in the "Super Mario Bros." cartoons, Spryte the fairy in "The Legend of Zelda", Miss Demeanor in "C.O.P.S.", and Prudence in the "Beetlejuice" TV series.

Since moving west, she has voiced many Anime characters including Gotenks in "Dragon Ball Z" and Flay Allister in "Gundam Seed". Most recently, she's best known for Nightmare Moon and Rarity, some of the main characters of "My Little Pony: Friendship Is Magic", also "Nerds And Monsters", Littlest Pet Shop", and many other cartoon and anime series.



Michelle Creber

Original voice of Applebloom, singing voice of Sweetie Belle, singer and actress

Michelle Creber is known internationally as the speaking/singing voice of "Apple Bloom" and the singing voice for most of "Sweetie Belle's" songs on "My Little Pony: Friendship Is Magic". She is the youngest member of the regular cast and was only 10 years old when her strong vocals were recorded for "Hush Now Quiet Now" back in season one. Michelle is also a talented young actress who has already appeared in several TV shows, movies and theater productions. As frequent collaborator, Michelle has recorded songs with Andrea Libman, Daniel Ingram, The Living Tombstone, MandoPony, Mic the Microphone and of course...



Gabriel Brown a.k.a. Black GryphOn

Singer, actor, voice actor, songwriter, animator

Black GryphOn is one of the fandom's most popular and versatile artists. He is known for songs like "Proud To Be A Brony", "Crusader", "Faster Than You Know", "Academy" and "Zero Gravity" and for his "licious" animations (Twilightlicious, Rainbowlicious, Pinkalicious, etc). He is also a popular "reactor" on Bronies React and along with Michelle was one of the co-creators of the MLP parody music video "Tweet It". After the successful cover of Michael Jackson's "Beat It", Michelle and Gabe have continued to work together; recording, performing, touring, creating comedy sketches and releasing original co-written songs. In addition to panels, Michelle and Gabe will be performing live at Galacon's Gala!

Gala Night - The “Mane Event”

The Gala Evening

The Gala Evening takes its inspiration from its name-sake. For a couple of hours the Main Hall will be transformed into a venue for a fancy evening with all of the class but none of the snob! No admission fees or separate tickets are necessary - put together a stylish outfit, bring some courage to dance, and you're all set.

We will open the dance with two live performers. First on stage is Sketchy Sounds then followed by Michelle Creber. The second part will be a mix of different genres of dance music played by Vocal Score ranging from smooth to energetic.

Towards the end it will get energetic again as Black GryphOn enters the stage to heat up the finale. And probably Michelle will be on stage once again to perform with him.

To ensure that the evening has some class to it there will be a simple dress code in effect. It's not complicated but make sure you take the time to read it and choose your outfit accordingly! The convention staff has the final say in terms of acceptance or denial of a dress.

The Dress Code - “Suited for success”

- Your outfit needs to be decently presentable. Think of a job interview for a position with formal dress code like a bank or similar business. Or even a fancy dress for a wedding. If you're unsure about a specific clothing item, ask yourself if someone would honestly put it on for a job interview, a company meeting or a wedding with formal dress code. If the answer is “yes”, then it's good to go.
- No shorts, no T-shirts. Generally, no leisure wear. You don't need to bring a tuxedo but your average casual clothing is not enough.
- Pants, skirts, and shirts are preferably unicolored. If there is a pattern (like stripes) maximum 2 colors. No multiple patterns (like a lumberjack shirt), de-

cals or other kinds of embroidery (like Western shirts). Shirts with short sleeves are allowed. Jeans are only acceptable if they look on par with a good pair of cotton pants (for example, a fine pair of black jeans works). Bluejeans are not accepted.

- Length of skirts and dresses: Minimum length allowed of skirt/dress and cut outs is 4 inches (10cm) above your knee. Everything shorter is not acceptable and can be rejected. Cleavage on dresses is generally allowed, if it is not too revealing (minimum 50% have to be covered) or sexually explicit.
- No sports shoes or other kinds that are considered casual. A decent pair of black or unicolored shoes already work. Boots are allowed, if they fit to the outfit or costume.
- Cosplay and costumes are allowed as long as it fits with the general dress code rules: Formal but not too casual or unfitting. The same applies to cross-dressing.
- Military styled costumes are only tolerated as long as it looks fictional. No real world related clothing or symbolism. Also no weapon props.
- Overall, apply common sense and you should be good to go! As long as the minimum is fulfilled you are allowed at the Gala Ball. See this as an opportunity to really dress up nice.

Minimum Basics Men

Formal shirt, long pants or fine fabric jeans, lace-up shoes or similar (no street shoes)

Optional: vest, jacket, tuxedo, necktie, bow or neckerchief

Minimum Basics Women

Blouse, long pants/fine fabric jeans or a dress, lace-up/heelled or flat shoes (no street shoes)

Optional: skirt, vest, jacket or bolero, tuxedo, necktie, bow or neckerchief

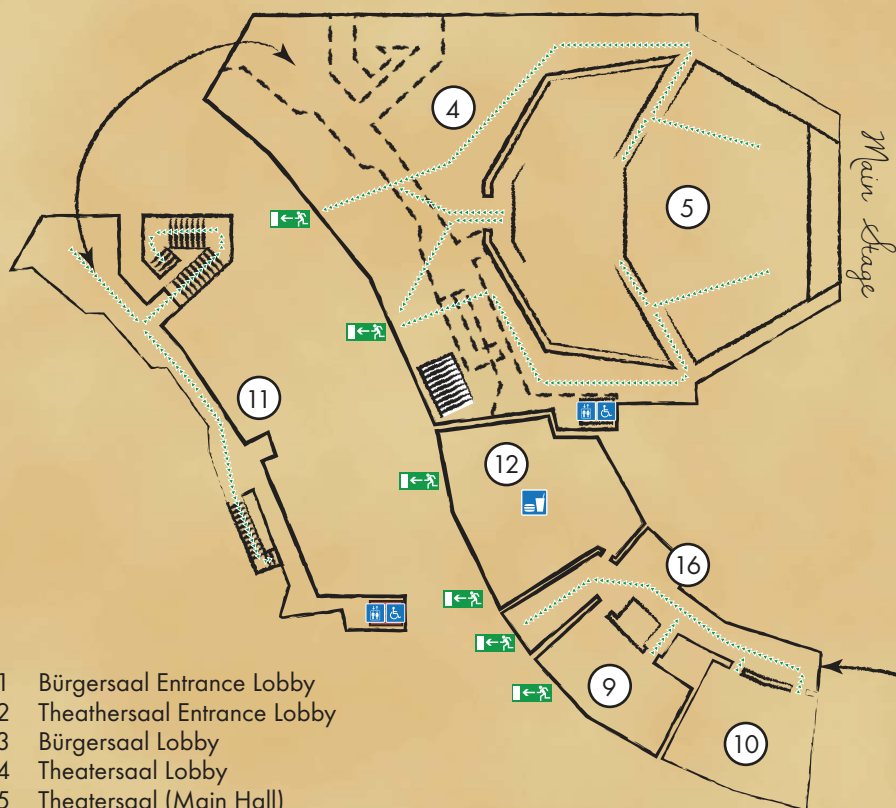

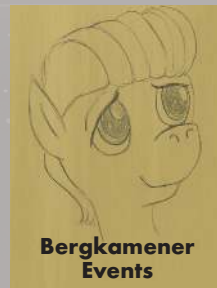
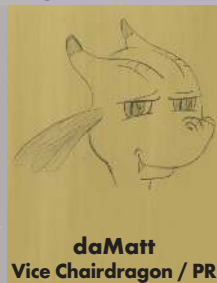
