Adventurer's Code of Conduct

By registering for this digital event, you agree to abide by the rules as set forth below:

1. Attendees will keep all posts "G/PG" or SFW in all 'public' digital spaces of the virtual convention. Attendee acknowledges that 18+ or mature topics will be kept to specifically designated 18+ channels, assuming that the attendee has purchased an 18+ pass. Attendee agrees that should this rule be broken, they will be warned, and then removed from public space without refund.

For guidance on what this means, the content must pass both these tests:

- a. It must not be likely to cause a problem at a fairly liberal workplace.
 - b. It must not be likely to cause a legally serious problem to knowingly expose a 13-year-old to it.
2. Attendees agree that they will not personal attack other users on the server in chat and keep discourse civil. Eg: "Proposition C-5781 is crazy.", good conversation. "User5781 is crazy.", would be considered a personal attack.
 3. Attendees will not purposefully engage in activities that would make convention channels unusable. This could include including spamming, Animated images with large rapid color changes (sometimes called "seizure images"), or disruptive behavior are not permitted.
 4. If an Attendee is asked to stop a behavior by a moderator, it is expected that the attendee will be polite, respectful and stop the behavior in question.
 5. Abusive or harassing behavior towards convention volunteers or other attendees will not be tolerated. If an attendee is found to be abusing volunteers or other attendees by way of Fighting, abuse, racism, sexism, homophobia, transphobia and other such behaviors, they will be immediately removed from Vancoufur digital convention spaces.
 6. Attendees who purchase an 18+ pass certify that they are older than 18 years old on March 1, 2021. Only those with an 18+ pass will be granted access to NSFW areas and 18+ content. Should anyone be found who has purchased an 18+ and is revealed to not be 18 or older, they will be removed immediately and ejected from Vancoufur's virtual convention space.
 7. Attendees are expected to exercise good judgement and respect the rights and of others in the digital convention space to enjoy the event.

Repeated violations of the above rules may result in a ban from future BCAEA events.
