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A Message from the Chair



Welcome Attendees to VF2022: Evfurquest Full release!

It's been a long road these last couple of years. Last year, we had our "beta" con as a completely online event to give you a taste of Vancoufur when it would be back to being in person, and thanks to everyone doing their part to get vaccinated, mask, social distance and sanitize, we've finally been able to come back to a live event.

Despite that, VF2022 is not a "normal" VF. Unfortunately, covid had some more surprises in store for us with the omicron variant that put us behind where we had hoped to be in terms of coming out of the pandemic. There are unfortunately still some restrictions in play we have to follow to ensure everyone's safety while still being able to reclaim some measure of in-person fun. I hope you will observe these simple measures to make sure that no one gets sick at this event, and that it sets a good example for events like Vancoufur coming back from covid. Wear your mask, sanitize your hands, social distance, and if you feel sick, stay in your hotel room or go home. Tell your friends, so they can make an informed decision if you have to leave due to feeling ill.

I know some people are just not yet comfortable attending a larger event even with all the precautions such as vaccine cards, regular sanitizing, capacity limits, mandatory masking, etc that we have in place. This is why we are also running concurrently a digital event with new and

improved VR chat locations, Minecraft serve, and streaming from the convention live to twitch. The hope is this will become a regular thing so that we can welcome people from all over the world to our digital event, even if they can't make it to our RL one. Our amazing volunteers have even come up with creative ways to cross the virtual and real worlds to interact between the two!

Another challenge we've faced is the lack of volunteers. We know people are very tired from covid, or scared. But there are many ways you can help, online and off. If you want to volunteer some of your time and earn some rewards, you can do so any time at con. Just go to our volunteer desk and say you'd like to help. We'll find you something to do. Parents, if you're stuck waiting for your kids, consider volunteering while you're waiting. If you don't want to volunteer, at least, try to be kind and patient if things aren't running exactly butter smooth.

One thing we've been very proud of is how far we've been able to take the Evfurquest theme in two years. There is a plethora of lore on the website (vancoufur.org/lore), as well as several audio play episodes, and ads, and of course the opening and closing ceremonies, all carrying through a fantastic narrative, woven together by our writing and theming teams. It has been an absolute pleasure to see the sheer creativity of the VF team, artists, writers, crafters, bring this theme to its culmination at VF2022.

I want to personally thank every one of the dedicated volunteers for their hard work this year, as well as my vice chair, Sha'Kaar for sticking with VF and me through these last two years.

As we finally bring the Evfurquest story and theme to a conclusion, and as my time as chair comes to a close, I hope you will all find adventure in this year's convention and make memories and friends that will last for a lifetime.

COVID-19 Policy

**TO PHYSICALLY ATTEND VF2022,
YOU WILL BE REQUIRED TO SHOW PROOF
OF YOUR COVID-19 VACCINATION STATUS.**

**ALL ATTENDEES WISHING TO ATTEND THE
PHYSICAL EVENT MUST BE FULLY VACCINATED
BY THE DATE THE EVENT STARTS.**

If you have not been fully vaccinated by the convention date, you will not be able to pick up your badge and physically attend the event. At present it is too dangerous for those who are unvaccinated (regardless of the reason) or only partly vaccinated to attend our event. This includes all domestic and international guests.

These are the requirements to be able to hold our event as outlined by the BC government. There will be no exceptions to the vaccination requirement. We will also be taking whatever other steps we need to be based on provincial Health guidelines, including social distancing, hand sanitizing stations, and restricting occupancy in convention rooms (such as panel rooms) as required at the time of the event.

Masks are currently mandated in all indoor spaces in British Columbia, Canada. We anticipate that this requirement will remain in place, however, if it changes, we will update this information.

Adventurer's Code of Conduct



This Code of Conduct is to ensure that the furry/Anthropomorphic community can enjoy Vancoufur while also working to build rapport with the public and our venue and continuing to improve on that relationship. This code of conduct puts expectations of behavior for our attendees at our event that we expect everyone to follow. If there is a conflict between departmental policies and the code of conduct, the code of conduct shall take precedence.

The code of conduct is not an exhaustive list of dos and don'ts. Any behavior that adversely effects or causes interference with the event and operations of Vancoufur, including but not limited to its relations and reputation within the community, municipality, venue, and/or public is strictly forbidden. This includes disregarding or interfering with instructions or guidance from Vancoufur staff during the performance of their duties.

Violation of the code of conduct may result in the suspension or revocation of your Vancoufur membership by Vancoufur staff. If any Ranger or Security staff believe you may be a danger to yourself or others, the venue, or other guests, you will be asked to stop immediately. If the behavior persists, your badge will be revoked and you will be asked to leave. If the infraction is severe enough, such as harassment or violence (sexual or otherwise), or multiple first hand credible behavior complaints, it may result in a ban from future events hosted by the BCAEA. Should someone be found to be an inadmissible attendee that has registered, they will have their registration revoked, and be removed without refund.

Attendees are advised that anything illegal outside, is also illegal inside the con, and that unlawful behavior may be reported to authorities and your badge revoked should Vancoufur staff receive credible complaints from other attendees, the venue, or the public. This includes local bylaws, as well as provincial and federal laws.

BADGES AND ADMISSION

Your Vancoufur Membership includes a badge that is your pass to convention events. This badge remains the property of Vancoufur until the end of the convention.

While at the con, the badge must be worn and visible at all times. Anyone attempting to access Convention specific areas without a badge will be asked to display their badge, or will be denied entry and asked to leave.

Badges are Non-transferable. Your Badge is for you and you alone, and may not be loaned, given, resold, or used by anyone else for any reason during the convention.

Government Photo ID and Vaccine Status must be presented at registration to complete your reg and receive your con badge. Government ID must be current, and can include a Government ID card, Driver's License, or Passport.

Underaged Members: Vancoufur recognizes all attendees under the age of 18 at the time of the convention as minors. Children age 12 and under are free, but must be supervised by a legal guardian or parent who holds a valid membership badge at all times. Minors will not be permitted into spaces designated 18+.

Inadmissible Attendees: Vancoufur reserves the right, at the chair and executives' discretion, to refuse or revoke membership at our event for any reason to protect the safety of attendees and membership.

No refunds. However, we will consider each instance on a case by case basis to determine if issuing a credit for the following year is appropriate based on individual circumstances. We will not issue refunds if you are removed for violating this AUP or inappropriate behavior.

EVENT SPACE

Vancoufur is a private event taking place in a public venue. Event space is limited to attendees with a valid badge however, members of the general public may be present in open or public spaces.

Attendees must clothe, costume and conduct themselves appropriately in these shared spaces. If you are unsure, please ask at Operations prior to wearing. Please see our Apparel Guidelines for more specifics.

Attendees are not permitted to at any time be exposing themselves (genitalia) in any convention or public spaces. Violations of this may result in a revocation of membership.

Attendees will be held liable should they be caught damaging the venue in anyway.

Sleeping is not permitted in the convention space, nor in the venue public spaces such as the lobby, hallways, or restrooms. Attendees found to be sleeping in such places will be removed.

Props & Weapons: Prop weapons constructed of non-hard, non-harmful materials are permitted for costume purposes. Weapon props should be registered with Ops prior to use. Silly string or other substances that could damage the hotel are also not permitted.

For specific events, an area or room may be designated as 18+/adults only. Access to such events will be strictly controlled by ID/badge checking at the door or entrance to the area.



ALCOHOL, DRUGS, SMOKING/VAPING

Alcohol must be only in the possession of, consumed by only persons of legal drinking age (19 in British Columbia) or older and only when served by a venue bartender/waiter, consumed within designated spaces such as the hotel bar/restaurant, event with a venue bar/bartender, or in the privacy of your own hotel room.

Anyone found to be providing/serving alcohol to a person under the age of 19 is breaking the law and may have their membership revoked and/or reported to police.

Alcohol is not permitted in event space such as panel rooms, dealer's den, games rooms, etc. Please only consume alcohol in the bar/restaurant, your room, or within specific events with a hotel bar/bartender present. (eg: GoH dinner)

Illegal recreational drugs are prohibited. Marijuana is legal in BC, however, it may only be consumed in designated smoking areas outside of the front of the hotel. Vaping, and smoking of any kind is prohibited in the hotel, in hotel rooms, and on balconies. Only smoke in designated areas.

Attendees found to be vaping or smoking in their rooms may be subject to penalties or fines from the hotel.

Please enjoy responsibly. Please follow all hotel signage regarding smoking or vaping. Attendees who are found to be intoxicated to the point where they are at a risk to themselves or others, or behaving belligerently or violently, may be asked to leave either temporarily or permanently at staff discussion.



HOTEL ROOMS

Do not post any notices, advertisements or glue/affix/tape anything to walls, ceilings, doors, or floors of our venue without first getting permission. Please use designated posting spaces for notices, DJ fliers, posters or other advertisements. Items using the wrong adhesive or in unapproved spaces will be removed.

Do not attempt to alter, use, misuse, damage, deface, or misplace objects in the venue space unless you've obtained specific permission from the con staff. Attendees must immediately heed any direction or request from venue staff. If there is grievance, attendees must comply first with the venue's request, and then report to Conops after and provide details.

As per Hotel policy, the renter of the hotel room is responsible for the room's condition and any use thereof. Vandalism, damage, or destruction of hotel/venue property may result in severe consequences including but not limited to revocation of membership, removal from the hotel as well as being held financially responsible with possible civil/criminal prosecution.

During late evening hours, (11:00pm – 8:00am) noise must not be audible in other hotel rooms. Note that dedicated subwoofer or high bass audio systems are prohibited for room parties as they cause noise problems.

Attendees are reminded that smoking/vaping in hotel rooms is not permitted, and that providing alcohol to minors is illegal.

Parties that are not on a loud floor and not registered with the Party Ambassador will be shut down. Attendees may have gatherings and room visitors, but be respectful and practice masking and Covid safety. Any gathering that generates noise complaints will be shut down.

Vancouver Rangers will do their best to help resolve noise or conduct complaints between attendees and the hotel. Please party responsibly and be respectful of other guests.

PHOTOGRAPHY & MEDIA

Vancoufur is a private event. As such, media/reporters/youtubers/podcasters are permitted in convention space only after registering as media in advance and obtaining a press pass from Vancoufur.

Media coverage, filming and photography is prohibited without prior authorization and written approval. Recordings or photography for private use is permitted. Unauthorized media shall be removed from convention spaces.

Media found to be distributing or licensing photography or video footage for or on behalf of a media organization; the BCAEA is empowered to seek damages of up to \$10,000 CAD.

Vancoufur reserves the right to take photography or video footage for promotional purposes.

Photographers and videographers authorized as 'staff photographers' will wear identifying badges to show their status as convention photographers.

Photography and Video is not permitted in the Headless Lounge, or Dealer's Den. No artwork or merchandise may be photographed without first obtaining consent from the dealer/artist.

Vancoufur reserves the right to deny entry to any/all media or grant conditional entry subject to additional provisions including, but not limited to continual escort/supervision by designated staff.

Inquiries or requests regarding media, video, or press appearances at Vancoufur may be made to media@vancoufur.org. Requests made at, or just prior to the event may not be responded to immediately. Please refer to Con Ops if there are any inquiries during the convention dates.

HARASSMENT & ASSAULT

Vancoufur wants to provide a safe and welcoming environment for people of all genders, gender-expression, sexual orientation, dress, age, race, religion, national origin or ancestry, creed, disability, or involvement/non-involvement in any group or activity at BCAEA sponsored events or venues. Any harassment or discrimination to any individual or group is unwelcome at our event.

Vancoufur has a zero tolerance on criminal harassment as defined in Section 264 of the Criminal Code of Canada. This also includes Sexual assault as per Section 150 of the Criminal Code of Canada.

If an attendee feels they are being criminally harassed or assaulted, fear for your safety, witness harassment of others, or sexual assault of others IMMEDIATELY contact Con Ops, a Ranger, a BCAEA Board Member, or contact the police.

Attendees are encouraged to report incidents to Con Ops or a Ranger IMMEDIATELY. Your safety is priority and we are committed to treating every incident with respect and professionalism. Don't leave your report until later, as once the event is over, our ability to address the issue is limited.

Vancoufur is NOT the place to start or continue disputes. Our staff cannot resolve existing external (outside of con) interpersonal conflicts or pre-emptively ban someone from attending based solely upon such.

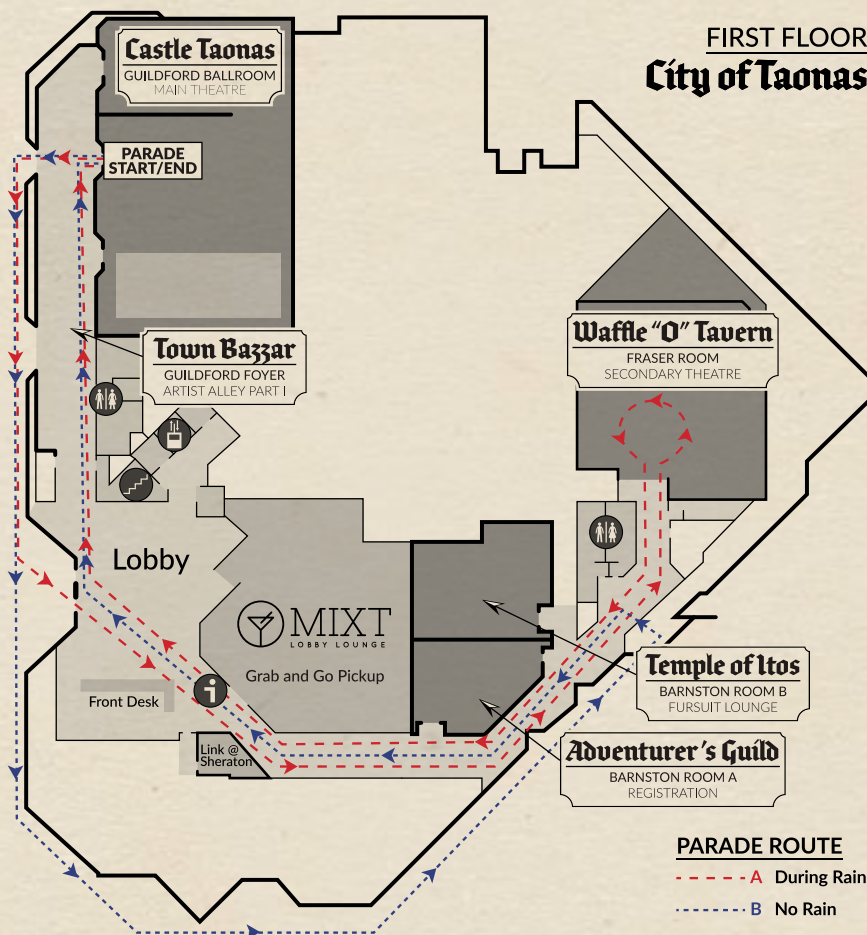
Behavior that is disruptive and detrimental will not be tolerated.

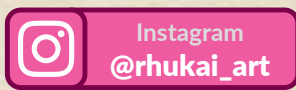
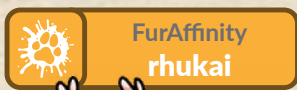
In another guise, Rhukai is the artist and writer of the long-running webcomic, Weregeek. Their recent comic work includes two werewolf anthologies, Can I Pet Your Werewolf , and A Howl, as well as an anthology of First Nations legends called Cautionary Fables and Fairy Tales: North America. They also host a regular drawing stream called Let Me Tell You About My Character, where they randomly generate and draw weird D&D characters.

Rhukai is a longtime LARPer and loves TTRPGs, including Shadowrun, Monsterhearts, and 5e D&D. They play Mykie, the dragonborn artificer, in the weekly actual-play 5e stream Something Wicked (twitch.tv/something5e), and Oogna, the orcish pit-fighter in another 5e stream called Trash Heroes (twitch.tv/weregeekcomics). They have also written a supplement for Monte Cook Games' The Strange, called Ohunkakan: The Living Myths, and they drew a comic about gnomes featured in Your Best Game Ever.

Rhukai is obsessed with birds and dinosaurs (which sound like the same thing except that if you ask them to tell you about non-avian dinosaurs and synapsids, they will go on about it for QUITE some time XD), and have volunteered at Greyhaven, a local parrot rescue. They have three birds; a cockatiel named Nutmeg and two lineolated parakeets, named Merry and Pippin.

Their other hobbies include cooking and trying new cuisines, kayaking, hiking, and identifying plants.

They are very honored to be this year's Guest of Honor, and are looking forward to meeting you all!





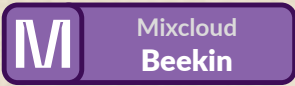
An adorable, feathery blue microraptor, Beekin (he/him) is an experienced DJ who loves vinyl and spins all the best 90's dance tracks.

Since the late 90's Beekin's character has been evolving, but he always has green eyes and the name "Beekin", a play on the word "begin", inspired by his return to Montreal, and a fresh start. This new beginning gave him a chance to prove himself, not only to others, but also himself after years of bullying.

In 2015, Beekin was given the opportunity to replace an employee that had quit unexpectedly in the Vancouver office. After impressing the Vancouver office manager he accepted a contract for few months it would take to find a new employee. Not long after, he began to ask when the position would open and if he could apply for it. After three months the job was his. This was a life changing moment for Beekin, and has never regretted the choice to move to BC. He sites this decision as a turning point in his life, and becoming a part of VF and its associated events as one of the best things that has ever happened to him.

He's a dedicated volunteer who has not only given hundreds of hours of his time to run AV and Theatre at furry conventions across Canada, but has also spent large sums of his own money to procure AV equipment to help sustain the furry conventions he supports for their AV needs. AV is one of the second biggest expense for furry cons outside of the hotel, and he's been instrumental in keeping those costs reasonable for the cons he supports. For the last few years he has been A/V lead at Vancoufur, Vanhoover Pony Expo, and at Vancouver's Howloween and Montreal's What the Fur. He also recently helped with Alberta's fur con, Fur Eh! He is also working on a new project to help with digital scheduling for furry conventions, again to help keep costs down and make the experience better for convention goers.

He's a creative soul with a big heart, a French Canadian with metis heritage who loves photography and dabbles in drawing and art when inspiration strikes.

Charity Auction

Our main fundraising event is our yearly charity auction. Donated items which have previously included artwork, fursuit parts, statues, commission slots, plushies and more are sold to the highest bidder with monies raised going directly to the charity, which this year is Qmunity.

Please note that all bids made in the auction are considered binding and payment is expected on the day, immediately after the auction. Do not bid if you cannot pay. Except where stated, all monies earned go 100% to the charity.

Bidding during a live auction

- You must have your badge with you, as your badge name and number are noted when you win an item.
- A full description and visual of the item will be stated before the bidding starts, so listen closely!
- Once the opening bid has been announced, raise your hand if you are interested. If multiple people show interest, the amount will be raised by \$5. This will continue until there is only one hand remaining up.
- If you wish to increase the bid by more than \$5, raise your hand and in a loud voice say your bid.

When winning the item:

- If your bid is the winning bid, a runner will go up to you and get your name and badge number to save with your won item. Please keep your hand raised so the runner has an easier time finding you.
- After that info has been taken down, you may either stay and continue watching or bidding during the auction.
- If you would like to leave with your item after winning it you may head up to the cashier to pay and pick up your prize.

An example bid

A plush has been put to auction. It's starting bid is \$15. 10 people raise their hands. The auctioneer raises it to \$20, then \$25, and now the item is at \$20. You want to bid \$50. After raising your hand, speak clearly and loudly say "\$50!" It will be announced as the new bid to beat!

Please note that all bids must be genuine.

Bid within your budget. If you cannot afford to bid \$500, please do not raise your hand and say you bid \$500.

By Sha'Kaar Thunderpaws

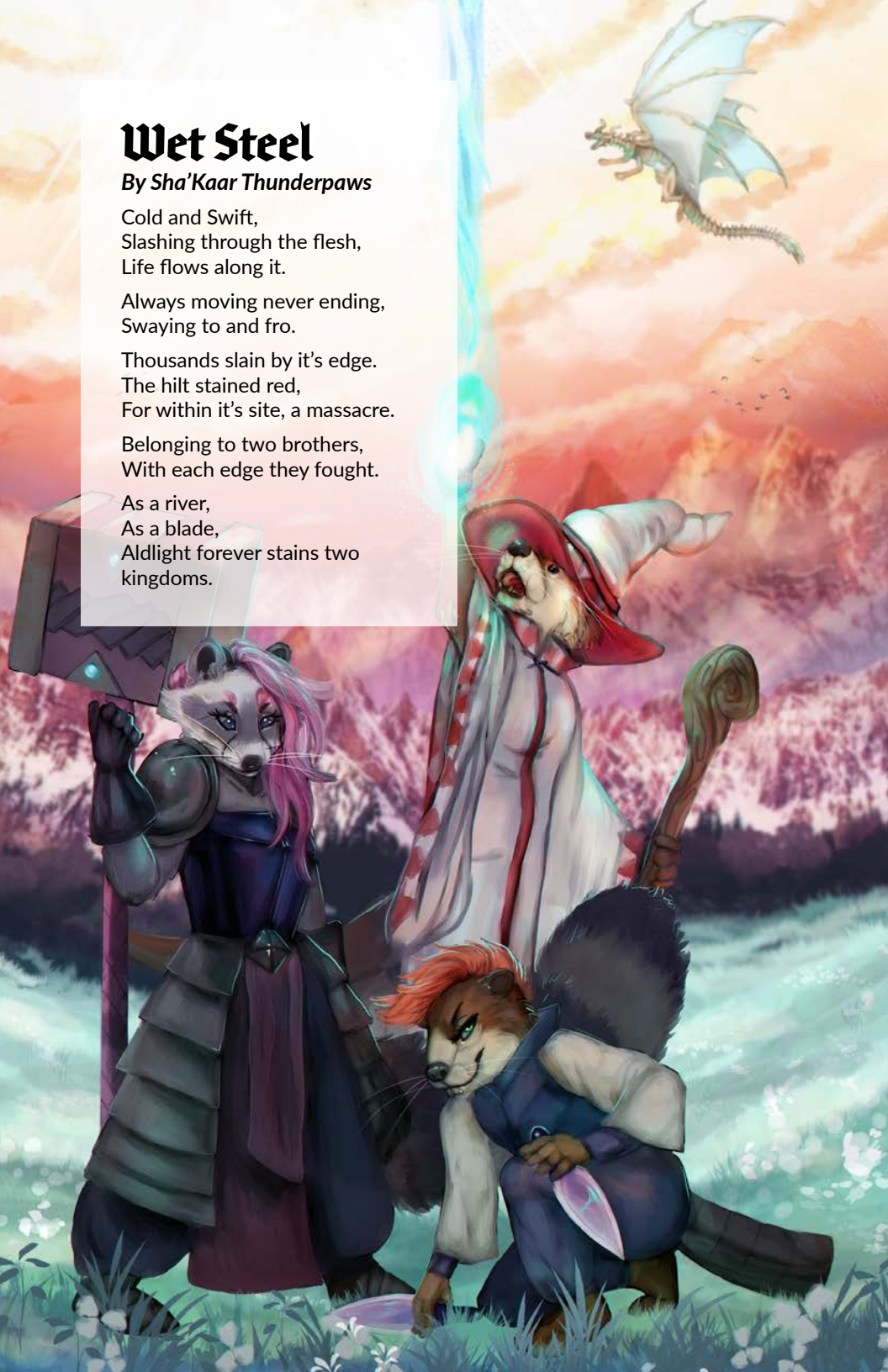
Cold and Swift,
