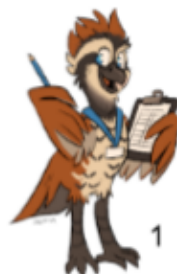

We are also committed to providing a safe and welcoming environment for all our members. Please take a minute to re-familiarize yourself with our **Code of Conduct** on the following page, so that everyone can enjoy this event. The well-being of all participants and care for our beautiful natural areas and their inhabitants is our highest priority. If you violate the CoC you may be asked to leave and barred from attending future Woods Flock events.

Code of Conduct

1. Be kind, to everyone and everything. That means no violence, harassment (verbal or physical), theft, or vandalism will be tolerated.
2. Leave wildlife alone! That includes not feeding wild animals.
3. Practice cleanliness. No littering, take care of your trash/recycling/dishes appropriately. Utilize restroom & shower facilities for their designated functions, or disposable wipes in absence of them.
4. Park quiet hours are 10pm to 6am. That is not a curfew, it just means no one but the people right next to you should be able to hear you. We ask during other hours to aim for a respectful level of (happy) noise.
5. The only open fires in the Woods Flock event area will be tended by Woods Flock staff. Employ proper fire management. Only heat-treated firewood is allowed into (or purchased from) the park, but downed wood may be collected from the immediate vicinity. Fires should be attended at all times and fully extinguished when done with.
6. Please no pets in the lodge or public use areas, other than on trails. They must be cleaned up after, leashed or otherwise contained at all times, and cannot be left unattended at camp sites, per park policy. Other pedestrians have right-of-way. Service animals are allowed.
7. No smoking in buildings/pavilions or public-use areas. Vaping is permitted in the open air but please be respectful of your fellow campers.
8. No alcohol is permitted in public areas of state parks, however attendees 21 and older may consume it within our reserved areas. Keep it in hand or stored so that underage folks cannot access it.
9. We ask attendees not to bring weapons, nor brandish items in a violent way.
10. Please keep adult material, including mature costumes or fetish gear, to private property (within tents, vehicles). Woods Flock is an all ages/ family friendly event. Although we hope it goes without saying, RSOs and other offenders are not welcome.

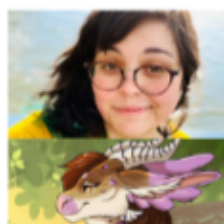

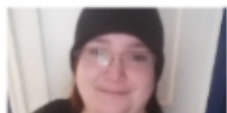

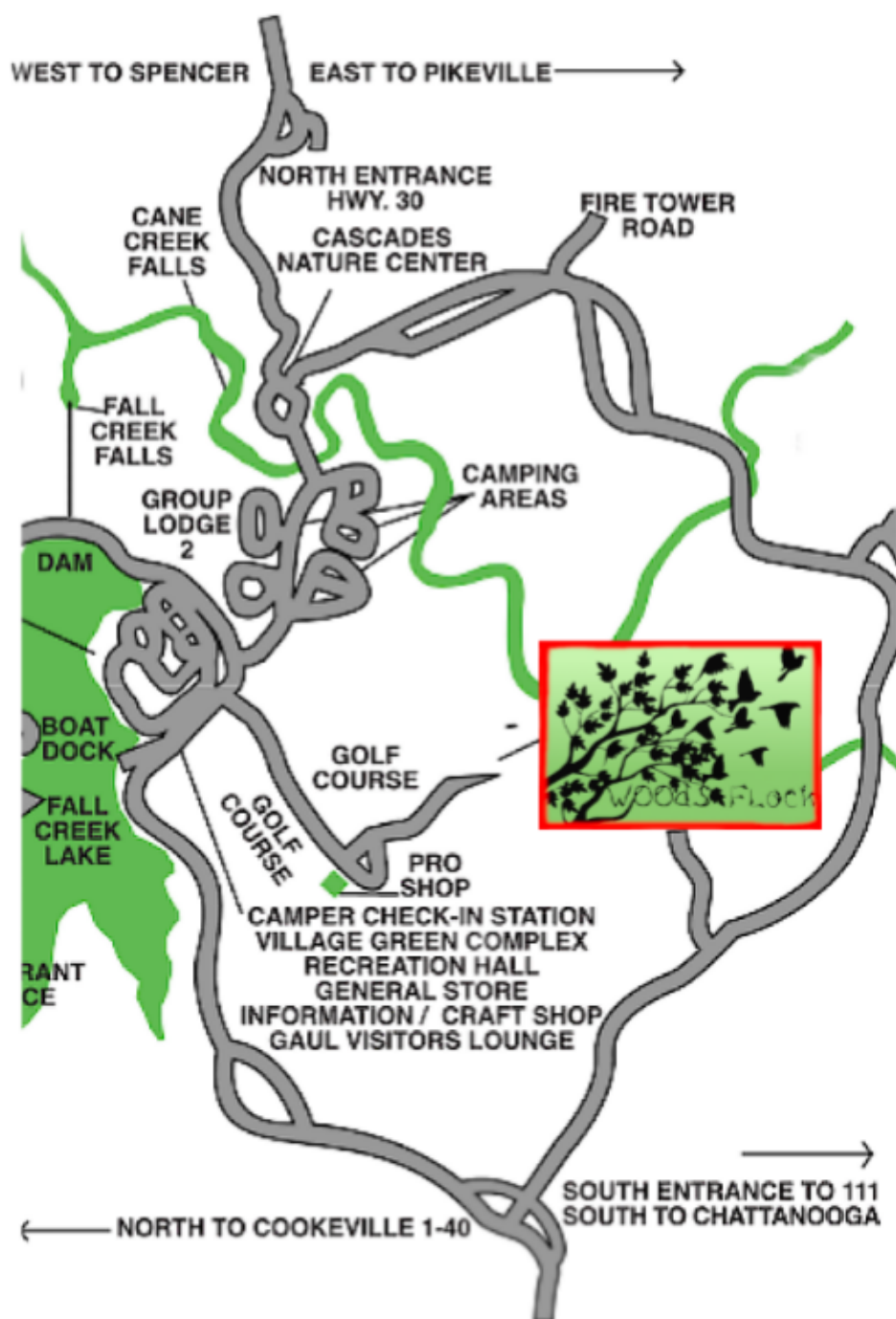
About Fall Creek Falls State Park

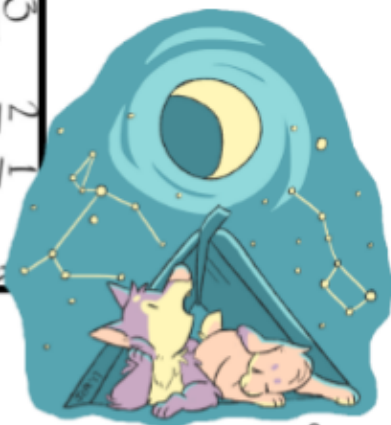
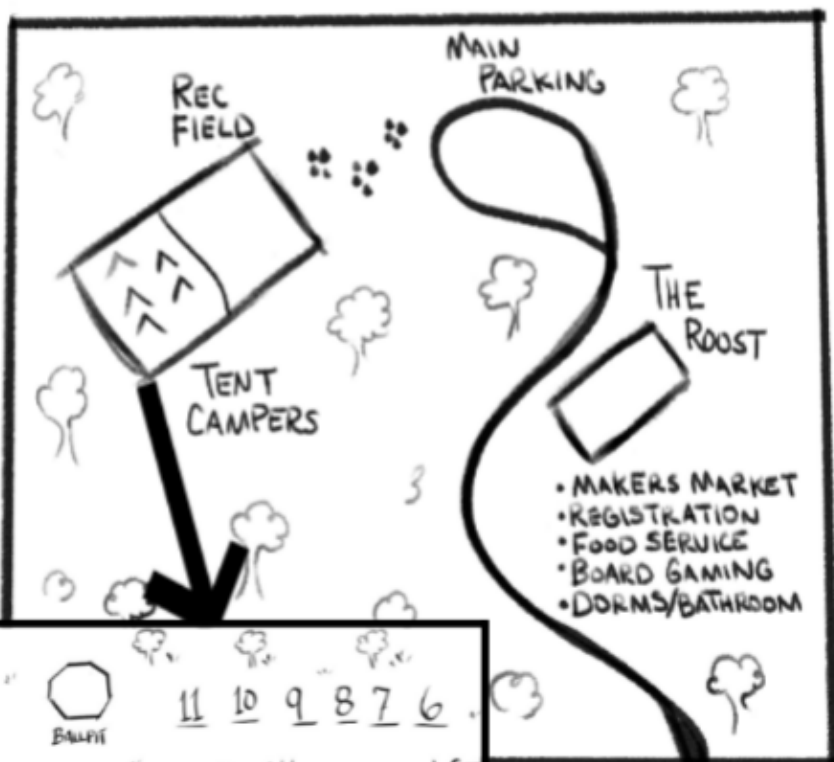
While Woods Flock is taking place in a private area of the park with lots of programming to offer, we do encourage folks to take the opportunity while you're here to enjoy the main park as well. You probably passed the Stables on the way in, for those interested in horseback riding. FCF also claims to have one of the most challenging 18-hole golf courses, which is a certified Audubon Cooperative Sanctuary.

In the "village" near the visitor center, you will find a general store/gift shop and snack bar. Down a side street from there is a boat dock where you can rent canoes, kayaks, paddleboats, or small fishing boats for quite cheap prices. And finally in that area there's also a pretty cool zipline/tree canopy challenge course, which you can use guest code **SPG15** to get a discount on.

But I think what y'all really want to see is the stunning natural views, right? I hope you will join us for one of the group hikes, but there are so many trails in the park and our group hike is only taking one (plus another for the guided ranger hike). However, whether you prefer a speedy hike (Fri) or a slower pace (Sun), our route will take you by the best overlooks starting from the Nature Center with Cane Creek Falls & cascades, all the way down to the base of Fall Creek Falls itself. If you want photo ops in fursuit, we can recommend the best spots to just hop out of your car without needing to hike. Please remember to leave only pawprints, and take only photos or memories!

REMINDER: Masks must be worn inside the Roost Lounge & Makers Market!

Registration & Camp Store: Where you checked in (Roost 2F), and will check out on Monday morning (before noon), or whenever you leave before then. This is also where you can bring charity auction donations, or bid on items. The Camp store has a limited selection of mostly snacks and drinks, plus Woods Flock merch, available by minimum donation (as shown at the store). This is Cash Only unless spending a min. \$10. This is also where the Charity Auction bidding will happen.

Health & Safety HQ: Small room @ the Roost (2F), down the walkway from the Market on the Dormitory side. Icy, who is an EMT, will be on call 24hrs but staffing the HQ from 10am-4pm. A volunteer will staff it as well as the Rec Field Staff tent during other times. If you need help at the rec field at night and cannot find a staff member out and about, go to the Staff area, which is where Icy's personal tent will be (or yell as loud as you can). You can always go to any staff for help.



Rec Field/ Group Camp: Accessible via footpath from the left side of the Parking Loop.

- NO VEHICLES ALLOWED.
- The Group Firepit will be tended by WF Staff; no other fires aside from camp stoves are allowed on the field.
- There will be a drinking water, handwashing station, and dishwashing station set up under a canopy in the Staff tent area.
- This is also where field toys will be stored, which anyone may play with as long as you return them after. Use only beach balls at the volleyball net - we don't want anything balls careening into tents!
- The recreation side of the field should be kept clear when not in use for playing/running etc. The exception is that chairs may be set up around the fire pit.
- In consideration of others, please keep noise, including boom boxes/bluetooth speakers to a reasonable level, at your own tent site or an area of the field where others can move away if they want. The fire pit is for acoustic instruments, stories, chatting, etc. not blasting music.

Dormitories & Bathrooms: These are in the Roost building nearer to the rec field/parking loop. 2F bathrooms reserved for tent campers, 1F for Bunk campers. In either case, if there is no line you may utilize an open stall. Please refrain from using the urinals as these are gender-neutral bathrooms.

SHOWERS are individual stalls and will have timetables posted on the doors so campers may reserve a time for use. Please bring shower shoes/flip-flops, towel, your change of clothes, and any soap/etc. you need as we will not provide any. We ask all weekend campers to utilize these facilities daily in order to keep our areas pleasant for all ^v^



Please refrain from using body spray/cologne/perfume inside, as some may have sensitivities. Roll-on deodorant is recommended!

Only bunk campers may enter the Dorm rooms, and should not enter any bays than their own unless invited (do not invite non-bunk attendees into the dorms). Do not overload your wall outlets. Food & drink is permitted if kept in closeable containers and as long as folks clean up after themselves.

Fursuit Lounge: Located on the first floor of the Dormitory building and accessible via the sliding door on the patio, which will be open 7am-midnight. It will have fans, drinking water & cups (though we encourage reusable water bottles in general), and a private bathroom. Do NOT use the bathtub/shower, though you may hang your fursuit in there. Beds may be used as seating, but please do not lie down for extended periods. Know your fursuiting limits and stay hydrated! Try not to suit alone, it is always good to have a handler, especially with the grounds being uneven. If you are feeling unwell, please seek or call for help!

Makers Market (2nd Floor Roost):

- There will be one entrance and one exit, however in case of emergency other doors remain unlocked for egress.
- Attendees will be allowed in freely unless it is becoming too crowded. Please do not linger inside the market room if a line is forming.
- Be respectful of the Makers! If you are not looking at their table or discussing a commission, you should not stand in front of their table.
- Bring cash! Connection is limited and card transactions may be unreliable.



Roost Lounge/Patio: Where most panels/activities take place, as well as food-service, eating, gaming, & hangout areas. Hot water, ice, and a microwave will be available during open hours. In order to reduce crowding, use of the Lounge will be prioritized (1= highest priority, 5= lowest priority). If it is determined too many people are in the lounge, you may be asked to go outside.

1. Food Service - picking up your meal plan during mealtimes will always be allowed, but please observe social distancing in line.
2. Attending panels, until designated chairs are filled. Chairs may be added if needed.
3. Eating at designated tables during mealtimes (we encourage folks to eat outside, weather permitting) - meal plans have priority.
4. Gaming (scheduled games will have priority over free-form gaming, unless there are not sufficient players).
5. Hanging out (drawing, fursuiting, talking, relaxing on the couches)

Kitchen: Located in the rear of the Roost Lounge (1F), STAFF ONLY behind the food service counter.

- After dinner, please scrape your food waste into the designated bucket and stack your tray/plate/utensils/cups in the dishwashing "window."
- The dishwashing SINK (NOT DISHWASHER) may be utilized by campers to clean their own dishes, provided it is not in use by staff and you stay out of the rest of the kitchen. If on the meal plan but not staying in the lodge we do ask you to bring your own meal-kit.
- If you have medication that needs to be refrigerated, label and contain it properly and we will store it for you on a designated shelf of the refrigerator.
- Reminder: this is not a licensed kitchen nor catering operation. Food service is being provided by volunteers with food handler training and all precautions will be taken for food safety, but participation in the meal plan is voluntary.
